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The attached map, field notes, and this report cover an area located in Jim Hogg County approximately S 13° 45' W, 29.7 miles from the county seat of Hebbronville.

The original survey work in this area was done by Martin Van Merrick during the period from 1872 to 1875. The corrective survey work was done by J. C. Eivet in 1882 and by me in 1937.

Your attention is called to the fact that Eivet, in making his resurvey of H & W Survey #34, failed to make the distance along the upper east line conform to Van Merrick's combined distances along the west line of AB&M Survey #55 and the lower west line of AB&M Survey #64. Thus, I believe Eivet left a 47 vara strip between the north line of Survey #34 and the upper south line of Survey #64 which I have corrected in my survey.

I began my survey at the southwest corner of H & W Survey #32, a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe at Point "A" on plat, from which I found Van Merrick's original witness tree, and ran N 9° 16' E, 931.68 varas with the west line of H & W Survey #32 to a steel barrel filled with concrete, Point "B", which I had previously set for the northeast corner of the Las Cuevitas Grant. I continued on the same bearing of N 9° 16' E, and at a total distance of 1869.10 varas, found the original northwest corner of Survey #32, Point "C" on map. Then I continued on the same bearing from Point "C", and at 9585.72 varas, came to a barrel filled with conorete, Point "D", which I had previously set for the northeast corner of the San Antonio Viejo Grant.

As Van Merrick's bearing along the west lines of Surveys #32, #33, #34, #64, and #65 was N 9° 15' E, and my bearing along the same lines was N 9° 16' E, I concluded that I must rotate Van Merrick's call bearings 0° 01' to the right.

I then went back to the original northwest corner of Survey #32, Point "C", and ran N 9° 16' E, 1965.00 varas (Van Merrick's call) along the west line of Survey #33, and set a stake for the northwest corner of Survey #33 and the southwest corner of H & W Survey #34. I then ran with the south line of Survey #34 S 89° 59' E, 1585.00 varas (call distance) and found nothing but set a stake for the lower southeast corner of Survey #34. I ran N 0° 01' E, 516.00 varas (call distance) and found nothing but set a stake for an interior corner of Survey #34 and the northwest corner of the A. Schubert Survey #2; thence, ran S 89° 59' E, 200 varas (call distance) along the north line of Survey #2 and set a stake for the upper southeast corner of Survey #34. I then ran N 0° 01' E, 1861.00 varas, which was Van Merrick's call distance of the west line of AB&M Survey #55 added to his call distance for the lower west line of AB&M Survey #64. Then I ran N 89° 59' W, 1397.80 varas along the upper south line of Survey #64 to intersect the west line.

While making this survey, I found that the field notes of my resurvey of AB&M Survey #64, dated September 2, 1937, are in error and will not close; also, that they will be slightly in conflict with the above position of Survey #34 which I consider to be Van Merrick's original position.
