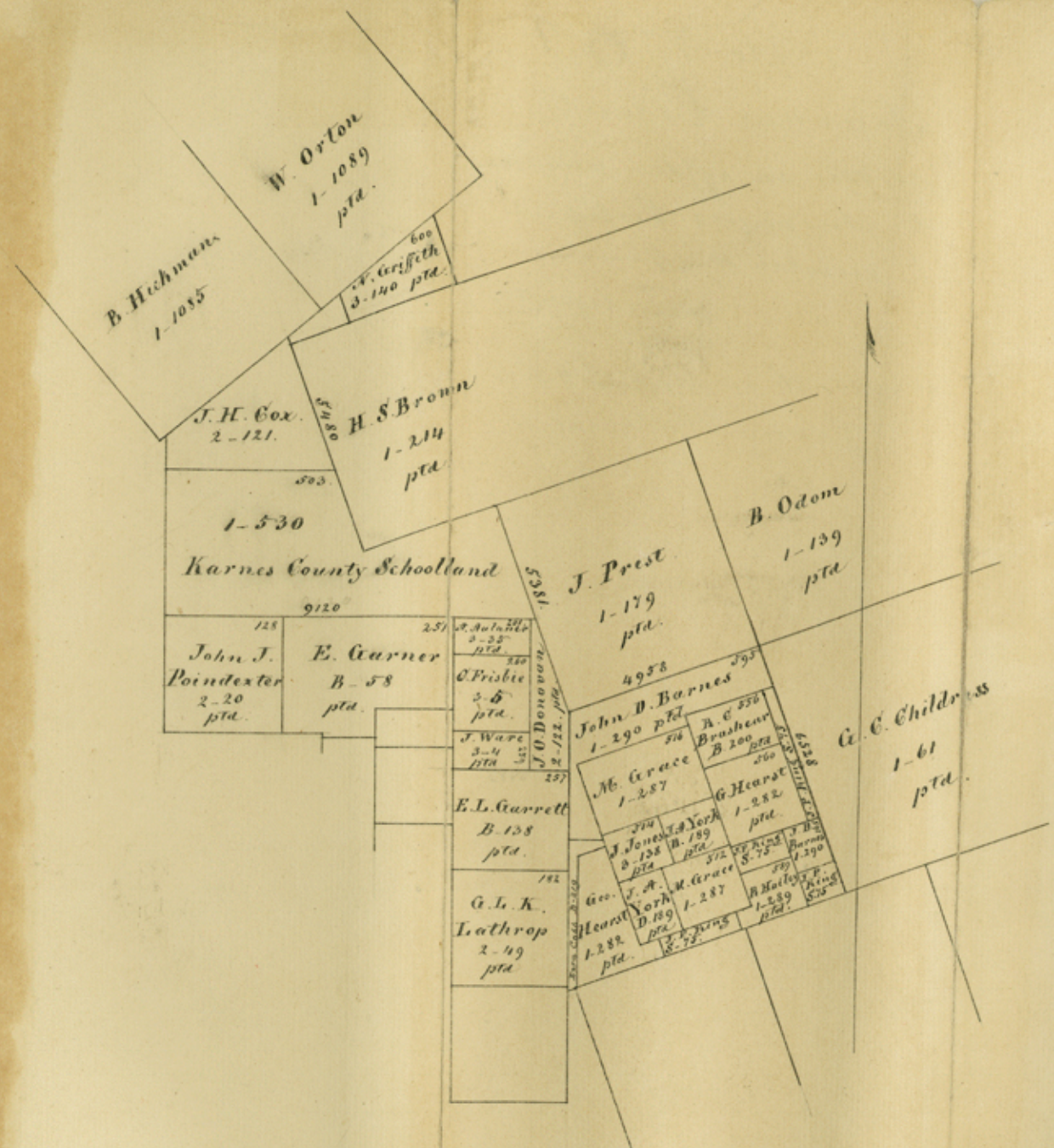

In regard to the discrepancy in the James P. King sur, 75-401a & D, The survey when made was supposed to run east to the L.C. Childers survey, But afterwards in making the other surveys the L.C. Childers line was found plainly marked at intervals through its entire length, This leaves a space of 280 paces between the West line of Childers and the East line of Brashear as run out when the survey was made, The East line of George Hearst sur. 560, and the East line of Brashear are a continuation of the same line and there is a distance of 280 paces between that line and the Childers survey

I Charles A Russell County Surveyor of Karnes  
County hereby certify that in running out the survey  
of John D. Barnes for 7,204.739 Acres varas, now on  
file in the General Land office, File. 290, Coliad. 1.  
That the Southern Boundary of James Preat  
survey was found by old marks at both the S.E. and  
S.W. corners of said Preat survey, and that in running

and survey of Barnes  
the <sup>west</sup> line of S.E.  
is found plainly marked and the  
distance from said W.C. Hill Survey to the survey  
of James Preat is as stated and given in the  
field notes of the several surveys of R. Hailey,  
M. Grace, J. A. York, M. Grace and J. D. Barnes,  
being a large surplus over the call of said line in the  
original field notes of G. C. Childers. Also that I have  
run out the west line of the James Preat survey  
and find the distance as set forth in the field notes  
of Joyce O. Donovan San Patricio, 123, 2<sup>d</sup> class, and Karnes  
County School Land 529, San Patricio, 1.

And I certify that I have run out the west and  
north line of H. P. Brown <sup>and also the south line of said</sup> survey and that the same  
is as represented in the field notes of said  
Karnes County School land and the field notes  
of James H. Cooy, 121 San Patricio, 2, being a sur-  
plus or excess over the actual distance called  
for in the original field notes of said Brown  
survey; and I would further state for the in-



formation of the land of free that the surveys generally  
on the south west side of the San Antonio river in old  
Goliad District, over run from 10 to 20 per cent above  
the calls in the length of them. In addition  
to my own surveys by which  
several surveys and lines alluded to, have in  
my possession a copy of field notes of J. H.  
H. Barnard formerly and for many years a surveyor  
of Goliad District, in which of a survey made  
by him from the south line of Brisbane League  
on the Medis to the <sup>North</sup> line of James Bradbery  
and that the distances made by him and  
the corners established by him upon the base  
of that survey correspond with my computations  
I further certify that the  
league of Standard 11  
the corner of J. Poindexter and run out the line  
East and connected with the Point line, and
