Dear Sir

On behalf of the heirs of Carlos Martinez, I enclose you a copy of the Surveyor's Plat and field notes of the Grant made to Carlos Martinez, by the Government of Spain, calling for three leagues front, on the right bank of the San Antonio river, and running back five leagues, for depth - situated in the present Counties of Karnes & Bee. -

The Martinez grant as well as that of Joaquin & Martin de la Garza, lying immediately above and adjoining it, on the San Antonio River, are designated by red pen lines, traced on a sketch furnished by your office, in or about 1869. -

The suit in favor of the heirs of C. Martinez was decided in the Dist. Court of Karnes Co in Nov. 1871 - confirming the grant to the extent of the red lines, as traced by J. Girard Surveyor - You will please have the lines of the Grant traced on the Map in

office - Please inform me if a certified copy of
the Decree of Court is required to be filed
in your office - If so, I will forward it
promptly - Respectfully.
