Dear Sir

Your of the 13th inst is at hand, requesting me to report to you the Condition of ^{my} Office as to County Map and the Records of Field Notes; And I have this to say that I have the Map of the County as furnished by the Commissioner of the General Land Office in 1872, and I have the Records of Field Notes of Surveys made from 1866 up to this time (Very few in number, this County was previously to the year 1866 a Separate Land District having procured a Certified Map of Surveys and a Certified Copy of the Field Notes Files and location of land in this County from the Surveyors office of the Land Dist to which it belonged, and it was on file in the Surveyors office of this County, but the Court House of this County together with all the Records, and maps was destroyed.

Golead County Record also was lost by fire to which this County belong, therefore we could not get the Transcript, the 2^d time from Golead, a part of this County belong to Boxer Land District. I suppose we could get that Transcript but that with the entire Transcript would not do, and it appearing that we could not get a perfect Transcript only from the Land Office; the Legislature in 1866 passed an Act, require the Commissioner of the General Land Office to furnish the Surveyor of Kansas County with Map and Transcript. The Preceding Justice of this County showed me a letter from you a short time ago, in which you say that the work will not be done until the money is deposited in your office for making Maps & Transcript. No one knows how much it will be until the work is done. This County has money in your City, and I think that you may not have any fears about your pay. Respectfully
