Sir!

I respectfully transmit enclosed

to your office a sketch and certificate showing the  
actual position of certain surveys on Spring Creek in  
Henderson County.

All the corners, marked on the plot thus o in red ink  
are actually found by me on the ground and corresponding  
with the original field notes, also are all the lines, where  
the boundaries are marked in red ink, carefully measured.

Beginning at the East corner of J. Gomber survey, Thence  
East, to the intersection of West boundary of H. Webb survey,  
Thence South to the SW corner of the latter, Thence East,  
and South to the SW corner of file 3-1154 (S. & M. P. R. R.) for  
120 acres. Thence South to the intersection of the North  
boundary of P. Gauno survey and from it to S. E. corner  
to the well established SE corner of the same. Thence  
following the plainly marked North boundary of the  
Ortiz League to the SW corner of P. Gauno. Thence  
the distance marked on the plot to the S. E. corner  
of J. Burk survey on said line. Thence in the  
courses marked on the plot to the S. E. corner of Ph. Zoller  
showing an interval between this and J. Burk survey.  
Thence following the eastern boundary of Ph. Zoller away  
westwards to a point, where the eastern boundary of M.  
Oliver's survey, so extended to the south intersects the same,  
further striking the W. corner of J. Gomber in an  
East course and following the southern boundaries  
of the latter to the beginning.

The distances in the J. Gomber survey are the

result of actual measurement, as marked in red ink, viz. 7940± x 1250±. - The error in Latitude must be explained by the circumstance, that on the eastern side the ground is more level, than on the western.

The position of the J. Frieder survey is given according to the actual position of the original corners on the ground. It seems that in surveying the three surveys surrounding the F. Gauvo survey, the original corners of the latter, as given by the feldwärter, never have been found, notwithstanding they are plainly established by well marked bearing trees. - From the same cause the A. L. Pfeiffer survey, as made and reported, is in conflict for about 80 varas with the F. Gauvo survey. I understand that the former is patented and beg respectfully to be informed, in what manner this conflict can be resolved. - Can the first patent be cancelled and a new one issued with corrected feldwärter? If there should be no objections against this statement, I will forthwith make out new feldwärter for file D-1154, J. Birkel and H. Scheller.



*Examination of S-1154.*

The examination of the larger survey file S-1154 in the name of the S.A. & M.G.R.R. Co shows the following discrepancies, to wit:

- 1) The connection of the J. Gombert North corner with the Fel. de Luna S.E. corner is N. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 245 varas, the Northline of the J. Gombert survey is S. 70° W. 120 $\frac{1}{4}$  varas and the distance between the Olivera East line and the Fel. de Luna S.E. corner is 1900 varas.

From these data the <sup>calculated</sup> distance between the J. Gombert West corner and the Olivera East line is 745 varas, while the fieldnotes of survey S-1154, call it 625 varas. Difference 120 varas.

- 2) According to fieldnotes S-1154 the distance between the J. Gombert East corner and the H. Wetz Westline (represented in conflict on the official map of Kendall Co) is 232 varas and the N.E. corner of this (S-1154) survey is 466 varas North of the S.W. corner of the H. Wetz survey. The H. Scheele survey is hereby drawn in conflict with the 160 acres survey file S-1154 in the name of the S.A. & M.G.R.R. Co.

- 3) The two surveys file S-1155 made for the S.A. & M.G.R.R. Co conflict with each other, probably owing to an error in the connecting line with the N.E. corner of the F. Stendeback survey. One of these surveys does not close.

4) The sketch represents the A. M. Holbrook survey according to its connections with the SW corner of the Juan Ortiz survey <sup>via R Hodge and H.S. Trousser</sup> and indicates by the dotted connection line the position of the same survey, which results from the connections given in the fieldnotes of the larger survey file S-1154.

If the position of the Holbrook survey as represented in connection with the J. Ortiz S.W. corner is correct, then the J. Gombert East corner is in conflict with the H. Wetz survey, and the S.A. & M.C. R.R. survey file 1155 (which does not close) is in conflict with the Thos Jackson and Fel. de Luna survey's

5) The southline of the Jul. Tabra survey is 904 varas. The same line, as H. Gotthardt's N. line is called 950 varas, and the O. Maraida S. line is 900 varas while the same line as F. Baehns N. line is called 939 varas long.

6) The conflict of the J. Scherr survey file 3-5795 with the Jas. J. Bettner section, appearing on the official map of Kendall Co., is removed by the explanatory statement of the surveyor on file with the field notes of the J. Scherr survey.
