

The State of Texas, var, N $9^{\circ}35' E$
County of King }

Field notes of connecting
lines run in King County Texas to find
the relative position of Blk X. R M Thomson
and Blk F H & T C R R Co.

- 1st Beginning at a stone and pits the East
Cor of Survey No 73, Blk 13 as established by
Geo L. Green, whence a mes lrs N $30 W$ 100 vs
a mes lrs N $80 W$ 46 vs, and another lrs S $75 W$ 74 vs.
Thence S $45^{\circ} W$ at 5700 vs pass a stone and
on top of round Knoll in break the North
Cor of No 83 Block 13 as made by 1st Surveyor
Knox Co. from Gun barrel Cor at
9504 vs drove a stake 44 vs S W of fence
line and cr^o fence line crs S W , whence
a mound lrs N $45^{\circ} W$ about 2 miles
Thence N $45^{\circ} W$ 1900.8 vs a rock and on ravine
N. side for N. cor Survey No 92.
Thence S $45^{\circ} W$ 1940 vs to edge of bluff 40 vs
S $45 W$ of N. cor said No 92.
Thence West 720 vs a point on ridge.
Thence North 133 vs a point at south end of a
ridge (probably the one called for in Field
notes of Survey No 258 Blk F)
Thence S $89^{\circ} W$ 1078 vs a stone and the
original N.E. corner of Survey No 257
Blk F. Kiowa peak also S $18\frac{1}{2} E$ at this variation
of N $9^{\circ}35' E$, also branch lrs S 120 vs.
Thence West 1878 vs to a point on East
line of Survey No 7 Blk F.
Thence N $0^{\circ}25' W$ at 206 vs stone and
mkd NE 7 at base of hill at 277 vs
stone and cr top of hill at 5873 vs
a large stone and or monument
for N.E. corner Survey No 10 Blk F.

W2. also beginning at E. line no 73,
thence N 45° W 3800 vs stone on road from
the N. line Survey No 98 at 5700 vs a
stone md in cedar breaks the E. cor
of survey no 6 Blk X for R M Thompson
This stone md is 3800 vs S 45 W from a
well established cor at the E. cor of
113 Blk 13.
thence S 45 W 437 vs a point. back
stone md. thence N 43° 30' W 465 vs
to stone md original N cor no 1 J. G. Eastis
thence S 46° 30' E 1938 vs to small stone
md at base of hill.
thence S 43° 30' E 1950 vs to a stone md
mkd P & E the S cor said no 1 J. G. Eastis
thence N 46° 30' E 1948 vs to a point described
by bearings in Field notes of said no 1
J. G. Eastis.
