Field notes of connecting
lines run in King County Texas to find
the relative position of BLK X. R M Thomson
and BLK F H & T C R R Co.

1st Beginning at a stone and pits the East
cor of Survey no 73. BLK 13 as established by
Geo L. Green, whence a mes brs N 30° W 1600
a mes brs N 80° W 4600, and another brs S 75° W 7400,
Thence S 45° W at 5700 vs pass a stone and
on top of round Knoll in breaks the North
cor of No 83 Block 13 as made by Co Surveyor
Knox Co. from Gun barrel cor at

9504 vs drove a stake 44 vs SW of fence
line and on fence line cor S, W, whence
a mound brs N 45° W about 2 miles
Thence N 45° W 1900, 8 vs a rock and on ravine
N. side for N. cor Survey no 92.

Thence S 45° W 1940 vs to edge of bluff 4000
S 45° W of N. cor said no 92.

Thence West 720 vs a point on ridge.

Thence North 133 vs a point at south end of a
ridge (probably the one called for in Field
notes of Survey no 258 BLK F)

Thence S 89° W 1078 vs a stone and the
original N.E. corner of Survey no 257

BLK F. Knowa peak brs S 18 1/2° E at this variation
of 9° 35' E, also branch brs S 120 vs.

Thence West 1878 vs to a point on East
line of Survey no 7 BLK F

Thence N 0° 25' W at 206 vs stone and
mkd NE 7 at base of hill at 277 vs
stone and on top of hill at 5873 vs
a large stone and or monument
for N.E. cor Survey no 10 BLK F

no 2. also beginning at E. corner no 73.
Thence N 45° W 3800 vs stone ~~on~~ round prairie
the N. corner survey no 98 at 5700 vs a
stone md in Cedar Creek the E. Cor
of survey no 6 BEK X for R M Thompson
This stone md is 3800 vs S 45 W from a
well established Cor at the E. Cor of
113 BEK 13.

Thence S 45 W 437 vs a point. built
stone md. Thence N 43° 30' W 465 vs
to stone md original N. Cor No 1 J. G. East's
Thence S 46° 30' W 1938 vs to small stone
md at base of hill.

Thence S 43° 30' E 1950 vs to a stone md
mkd P & E the S. Cor said No 1 J. G. East's

Thence N 46° 30' W 1948 vs to a point described
by bearings in Field notes of said No 1
J. G. East's.
