tificate No. 1 issued to B. B. B. & C. R. R.
co. This corner I found to be plain
and easily identified. Thence N. 81°
W. 13 miles or 24700 varas to the S. W.
corner of Survey No. 217 in Block A
made for said B. B. B. & C. R. R. co.
This corner could not be identified.
I continued my course N. 81° W. 5
miles or 9500 varas ^{at this point} ~~there~~ I establish-
ed a corner by setting a stone in
the earth this corner is in the right
position for the S. W. corner of Survey
No. 22. made for C. T. R. R. company by
actual measurement I still continued
my course N. 81° W. 2500 varas crossing
the Brazos River to the Original S. W.
corner of section No. 22. made for

D.M. R.R. Co. in Block G. This corner is easily identified on the ground the old hewn mesq. stake is still there and the bearings are still there. Thence S 81° E 6700 varas to the N.E. corner of a preemption survey made for Levy Kiley on the west line of David G Burnett Survey No 23. Thence North 2450 varas to the N.W. corner of David G Burnett Survey No 23. This corner is easily identified.
