Now do this for me and draw a draft on me with the sketch attached and I will not only pay the same but be a thousand times obliged to you too boot

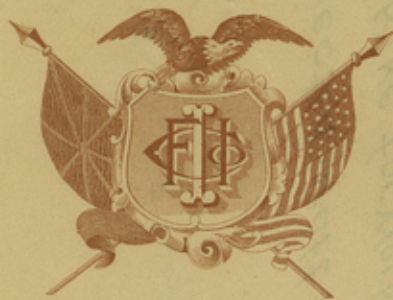
