I hereby certify that I made the connection of Blocks A, B, & C, Surveyed for the B B B & C R R Co. & H & H. R R Co. & Columbus Tap. R. R. Co. by actual chaining from the southern South East Corner of a survey made in the name of Allen Hines, evidenced by a Mesquit = Marked X bearing S. 24 E. 3 varas, and another Mesquit mark^d X bearing N. 20 E. 12 varas and further evidenced by it, being 700 vs. South of Winters Creeks near the mouth of same, in the County of Baylor.

Running West 5000 vs. North 26 20 vs. N 58 W. 29,000 vs. to the S. W. Corner of Survey No: 43 made for T & W. O. R. R. Co. for beginning Corner of Survey No: 1 "Block A" in the County of Knox made for B B B & C R R Co. At which point I erected a Stone monument 4 ft. in dia. and 2 ft. high, with a square Stone Block in Centre 2 ft. high above Monument numbered 1 - Thence North 88 60 vs. cross Salt Fork of Brazos River. 28000 vs. cross Big Wichita River 34200 vs. to the North East Corner of ^{Survey} No: 18 "Block A" made for B. B. B & C R. R. Co. At which point I erected

another monument of Stone and Earth 4 ft.
in dia. & 2 ft. high with a flat Rock in Centre
Numbered 18.

Thence West 32300 vs. to North West Corner
of Survey No: 14 "Block C" made for Columbus
Tap R.R. Co. At which point an Earth monument
was erected.

Thence South 18600 vs. Cross Big
Wichita River, 19000 vs. to the South West Corner
of Survey No: 5 "Block C" made for Columbus
Tap R.R. Co. At which point an Earth Monument
was erected.

Thence West 500 vs. Cross Big Wichita River 1500 vs.
Cross Big Wichita River 1900 vs. to North West
Corner of Survey No: 15 "Block C" made for
Columbus Tap R.R. Co. At which point an
Earth Monument was erected.

Thence South 15200 vs. to the South West Corner
of Survey No: 22 "Block C" made for Columbus
Tap R.R. Co. and extreme South West Corner
of "Block C" made for Columbus Tap R.R. Co.
At which point an Earth monument was
erected 4 ft. in dia. and 2 ft. high, with
a faced Mesquit Log in centre 30 inches
high, marked, No: 22.

Thence East 500 vs. cross Salt Fork of Brazos
River 34.200 vs. closing on original Mon-
ument numbered 1" in 120 varas, all
of which measurements were carefully
and accurately made - and evidences
the fact that the D. G. Burnett Survey
and a block of work made for the
H. & T. C. R. R. Co. is situated up the Salt
Fork of the Brazos River and further west
than is represented on the Map.
