Dear Sir:-

By Adam's Express tonight I am shipping you corrected field notes covering State Capitol Leagues 657 to 736. Following your instructions of August 16th. 1912, I carefully traced out upon the ground and searched for the original Capitol League corners. In doing this I found that many of the original corners were missing, and there are discrepancies existing between the original corners, which I found, which made it necessary for me to seek out all of the original corners which now can be found in this body of State Capitol Leagues to enable me to correctly construct these leagues upon the ground, thereby correctly determining their boundaries and also determining any and all vacancies which might lie contiguous with these leagues. Of course determining the boundary of these State Capitol Leagues determined only one side of such unappropriated school land as may exist, ~~but~~ This survey, taken with my resurvey of the State School Leagues under your instructions dated May 11th, 1912; also February 16th 1912; also November 18th 1911, and other instructions included in additional data and correspondence, all of which work has been done under my appointment as State Surveyor dated April 11th, 1911, when connected together as is shown in my field notes and on the blue print map which I have forwarded to your office showing State Capitol Leagues "657 to 736", fully determines all of the boundary questions in this vicinity.

The connections shown on this map to the original South corners of Sterling County School League No. 227 and all the original corners for School Leagues 209 and 210, determine the construction for the School Leagues in this vicinity and questions which may arise as to corrections for surveys in this vicinity all of which is important information for your compiling draftsmen and for your examining draftsmen. In fact the data which I am furnishing in these reports in connection with former reports must probably covers every possible boundary question which can arise in Cochran, Hockley and Lamb Counties; and will enable your office to compile maps for these counties that are absolutely correct and reliable.

I have undertaken to show all connections between original corners on map mentioned, a print of which is found on the back of my field notes. However if details are lacking on the map in any particular they will be found fully set out in my corrected field notes. You will note that in determining the position of State Capitol Leagues I extended my information to the abandoned leagues on the East, and used all of the information found to assist in making a correct construction for all of the surveys in this vicinity.
