

Lampasas Apr 24th 1873

Hon Jacob Kuebler, Com. G. S. O.

Sir.

As the proper officer in discharge of official duty I forward to You this sketch N^o 1. in order that proper corrections may be made in the Map of this County. It is the result of careful measurement to which I am ready to qualify.

1st. Beginning at the N^o & W corner of the John Gaston tract from which an Elm tree marked H N 23 to 25th. I run N 71 to 2630th. Thence N 17 W 330th. I strike S. C. Jacksons N W cor from which a large Elm oak marked H bears S 87 W 96th.

2nd. Beginning at the same corner of Gaston I run S 71 W 425th. Thence N 17 W 850th to the S W cor of R. H. Collette's plantation and 750th on the same line his N W cor a Corn Mesquite marked for the purpose.

3rd. Beginning at the S. W cor of John Gaston from which a Spanish oak marked H bears S 10 to 18th. I do N 66 to 17th. I run S 19 to 3808th. Thence S 71 W 139th. I strike the S. W cor of Joseph M. Carley.

4th. Beginning at M. Carley's S. W cor I run N 71 to 337th. Thence S 17 to 140th. I strike the W cor of a survey for John Woodruff.

5th. Beginning at M. Carley's S. W cor and a run S 71 W 220th. Thence S 17 to 542th. Thence S 71 W 327th. I strike the N W cor of J. Hughes N & W cor I run S 71 W 897th his N W cor a Elm oak bears N 30 to 47th. Thence S 17 to 687th. I strike the N & W cor. Thence S 17 to 1315th. his S W cor. a Elm oak bears S 74 to 13th. and at the N & W cor of L. H. W. Johnson bears S 71 W 80th.

The above statement of fact must be recognized soon or later and it hopes without delay making an important change in the map
