Thence N 71 E 250 vs a rock mound from which a Mesquit mark H has S 16 E 59 vs. Thence N 71 E continuing the same run 200 vs. a rock mound for McCashey N E corner 225 vs a rock mound for Straley S. E. corner an Elm has N 9 1/2 E 143 vs not plainly marked

Thence N 19 W 475 vs Straley's N. E. corner a rock mound Thence N 19 W 1820 vs. Thence N 71 E 220 vs. The S. W. corner of John Gaston's Survey a Spanish oak marked H has N 8 1/2 E 18 vs. a D. has N 65 E 16 1/4 vs
