

Field Notes of a survey of the North line of the John Burleson  
1280 acre tract - survey No 45.

Beginning at the N. E. Corner of the G. H. W. Johnson  
this Craigie tract from which an Old oak bears  $S 45^{\circ} E 13^{\circ} \frac{2}{3} V. 20$  No  
other witness trees could be found at this corner

Thence N. 71 E at 80 V. passed a rock mound the  
S. E. Corner of the Stolek's tract from a Live oak bears  $S 70^{\circ} E 7^{\circ}$   
at  $1631\frac{1}{2}$  V. struck the S. E. Corner of the St & Hughes tract from which  
a Live Oak marked bears  $S 67^{\circ} W 9^{\circ}$  a do stump  $N 48^{\circ} W 25^{\circ}$  at  
 $2200$  V. struck a rock mound the S. W. Corner of the Powel tract  
at  $2698$  V. searched but found no sign of corner - at  $2851$  V. found  
a rock planted for the N. E. Corner <sup>of No 45</sup> but witness trees could not be found  
at  $3051$  V. struck the S. E. Cor of the Powel tract from which a  
Live oak bears  $N 63^{\circ} E 18^{\circ}$  and a do  $N 80^{\circ} W 14\frac{1}{2} V.$  both marked

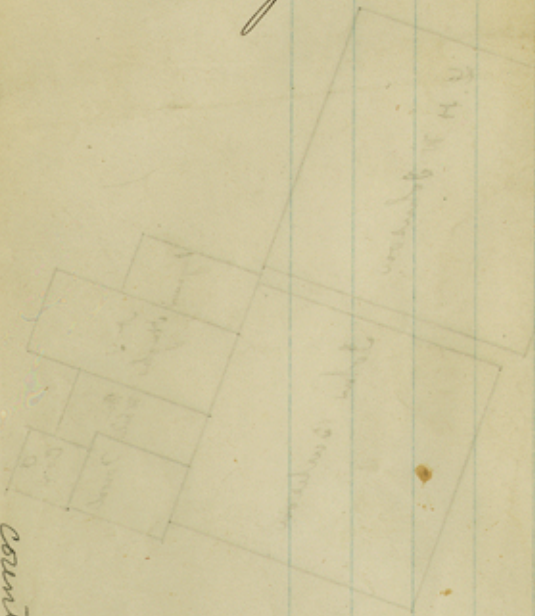
