



Field Notes of a survey of the North line of the John Burleson
1280 acre tract Survey No 45.

Beginning at the N.E. corner of the S. H. W. Johnson
third League tract from which a Pecan bears 945° W 13 $\frac{2}{3}$ vs. no
other cuttings here could be found at this corner

Shove N 71° 8' at 80 ft. passed a rock mound the
S. E. corner of the Holchiss tract from a Live Oak bears S 8° 7'
at 1631 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. struck the S. E. corner of the S. S. Hughes tract from which
a Live Oak marked bears S 67 W 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. ad. stamp N 48 W 25 7'
at 2200 ft. struck a rock mound the S.W. corner of the Powell tract
at 2688 ft. searched but found no sign of corner - at 2851 ft. found
a rock planter for the N. E. corner ^{of N 45} but cuttings here could not be found
at 3031 ft. struck the S. E. cor. of the Powell tract from which a
Live oak bears N 63 W 18 7' and ad. N 80 W 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. both marked
