County of McMullen I. M. O. Martin. County  
Surveyor of McMullen County do hereby certify  
that at the request of G. Prince. Heir of Geo. D.  
Robbins. and of J. G. & C. J. Dull and W. C. Dore. I  
made a Survey to ascertain the true location of  
Surveys lots 982 in name of Sebastian Rippstein. lots  
985. in name of Manuel Martinez. and lots 986. in  
name of Joseph Ofoer. all situated in McMullen  
County. I began at the lower corner of Survey lot  
36 on the Rio River. in name of J. Colston (it being  
abandoned Survey lot 36 in name of Rafael Gargal.)  
at the point called for by Thomas Grandy. County  
Surveyor of La Salle County. in his statement and  
sketch filed in the General Land Office Oct 14. 1884.  
in file D 2092. From which point I ran North 7379  
varas. and West 3252 varas. to the point claimed by  
said Grandy for S. E. corner Survey lot 982. This point  
is South 40 varas from Esperanza Creek. and South 30  
varas from a mob of large Live Oaks. The original  
field notes call for bearing trees. thus: "at Mesquit 4 in  
bis S 69 E 22 vs." I did not find any mesquites at this point  
and it seems to me that had the original corner been  
put here. the Surveyor would certainly have called for  
large Live Oaks. such as were close at hand. instead of  
a Mesquit. only 4 inches in diameter - I then ran  
North. At 40 vs. crossed the Esperanza Creek. at 580 vs  
crossed Rawhide Creek. at 1344 vs. looked for bearing  
trees called for in the original field notes. for N. E. cor.  
lot 982. but could not find them - I then ran West.  
At 320 vs. crossed Rawhide Creek. at 1344 vs. point  
claimed for N. W. cor. Sur. lot 982. looked for bearing  
trees. but could not find any marks - At this point  
there are several Mesquites and Live Oaks near by -  
I then ran <sup>North</sup> 1344 vs. to a point claimed by Mr. Grandy

for the ch. W. & cr. Omryy No. 985. Here I found no bearing trees marked. The field notes of said Omryy No 985 call for 2 Merints and x. and by the calls for the South line of the Jos Ofaer Omryy. Esperanza Creek should be 44 ins. East of this corner. So far from being case. the corner is on the high brushy divide between Ranhuia and Esperanza Creeks. no creeds being within one half mile of the point - I then ran West 50 ins. to the point claimed by Mr Prandy for S. E. cor. Jos Ofaer Omryy No 986. I then ran North through heavy chaparral brush. and on high land. (crossing no creeds). 950 ins. where I found a stake put by Mr Prandy for the ch. W. & cr. said Omryy No 986. No live Oaks in the vicinity. nor did any ever grow there. I then ran West 1160 ins. to a stake set by Mr Prandy for S. E. cor. Omryy No 988. I stopped here. finding that the Omrys would not fit any creeds or natural objects as called for. in their field notes. and that by putting them as claimed by Mr Prandy. they would be thrown on high chaparral ridges. and upon the poorest land in that section. instead of being along the valley of Esperanza Creek. where they undoubtedly belong - I hereto attach a map. (marked Exhibit A). showing the actual location of the creeds in that section. upon the ground. and the Omrys as claimed and located by Mr Prandy -

The Block of Omrys of which Nos 982. 985 + 986 are a part. were surveyed in 1852. by J. G. McDonald. Deputy Surveyor of Bexar Dist. I attach hereto (marked Exhibit B) a copy of a Certified Copy of his sketch. on file in the General Land Office. and have marked thereon. the corners at which he calls for bearing trees in his field notes. and a red dotted line. showing the lines he must have run. and upon which there were calls for Esperanza Creek &c - having made a careful study of the field notes of said Block of Omrys. in order to follow

the footsteps of the original Surveyor. as nearly as possible.

In order to do this. I went to a point 7379 vis. North. and 3002 vis. West of the upper corner of Survey No 1363. (which was the upper corner of Surveyクロス6 in name of Rafael Garga). on the Rio River. and ran experimental lines. as follows. North at 660 vis. South bank of Esperanza Creek. at Lake. here found a line tree marked by R. A. Brown. County Surveyor of Live Oak County. for East line of Surveyクロス2. and West line of Surveyクロス1 (C.C.S. & R.G. Co. R.R. Co). at 1065 vis. passed corner. established by said Brown. in a field. for the beginning corner of said Surveyクロス1. and at E. corner Surveyクロス2. at 1344 vis. put a stake. Ran West. at 420 vis. to head Esperanza Creek. at 1344 vis. put a stake. Then ran North. at 1200 vis. Esperanza Creek. (ran along a bend of the same). at 1304 vis. leave said Creek. at 1344 vis. Then West. along the ~~South~~ bank of said Creek 50 vis. Then North. at 520 vis. Creek. at 950 vis. put stake. Then West 1160 vis. put a stake. Then West at 80 vis. to head Gang Creek. at 1240 vis. Esperanza Creek. at 1900 vis. Then North. at 660 vis. Esperanza Creek. ran along bend of the same. at 870 vis. left same. and continued along West bank at 1470 vis. crossed same. at 1900 vis. Then West 120 vis. (found 100 vis North. on East bank of Creek. a Live Oak. marked on West side = very old.) From end of last <sup>row</sup> S. E. South 420 vis. where I found the original bearing trees of the N.W. corner of Surveyクロス2. and the S. E. corner of Surveyクロス1. viz: a Mesquit 8 in (now dead) and so disfigured by decay that only part of the ~~x~~ could be made out. This S. 14 1/2 E. 5 vis. and a Mesquit 8 in (now 12 in.) and upon which the ~~x~~ is plainly shown. This S. 46 1/2 W. 9 1/2 vis. Hence I ran South 40 vis. to centre of Esperanza Creek. and found old line trees marked =. I then returned to above corner. Hence ran West 50 vis. to centre of Esperanza Creek. on which

line I also found a Mesquit tree. marked thus =.  
All the above marks are very old. and establish without  
doubt. the N.E. corner of Omryy cto. 989. the S.E. corner of  
Omryy cto 990. and the N.W. corner of Omryy cto 988.  
From said corner I ran North. at 520 is. past a West of a  
Live Oak. marked =. at 2813 is. corner in the prairie. the N.E.  
corner of Omryy cto 990. Thence West at 1377 is. Esperanza  
Creek. at 1421 is. put a stake for S. W. corner of Omryy cto  
993. from which a large dead Live Oak is. ctg W 38 is.  
and a Live Oak stump is. ctg W. 32 is. These are undoubt-  
edly the original bearing trees for this corner. but the  
outer surface of the tree still standing has so rotted  
away. that no mark is visible. I then ran West line  
of said Omryy cto 993. North. at 60 is. crossed Esperanza  
Creek. at 240 is. crossed same again. at 51 is. crossed same.  
and passed a Live Oak. marked =. very old - at 860 is. passed  
an old Mesquit tree. a limb to which has grown  
out from just below the = and covers it in such a man-  
er as to preclude the possibility of the mark having  
been made at any time since the limb commenced to  
grow. These marks are very old and a plain. and show  
the exacts - at 1344 is. the N.W. corner cto 993. found  
stake. put by Mr Brandy in 1886. for S. W. cor. Omryy cto  
997 and S. E. cor. Omryy cto 998. bear ct 48 W. 26 1/2 is.  
Thence with West line Omryy cto 994. North. at 630 is.  
intersected a North boundary line of Omryy cto 1. (plainly  
marked) as surveyed by Mr Brandy in 1882. (as claimed  
by him at that time as the North line of Omryy cto 997).  
at 1460 is. (making a surplus of 116 is. which should  
be divided between Omryys cto 993 and 994.) found  
Live Oaks. answering to the bearings called for in the  
Title abstracts. but the trees having been burned. showed  
only large scars - the N.W. corner Omryy cto 994.  
I then ran West. at 197 is. crossed Esperanza Creek  
at 760 is. found Live Oaks. answering the calls for 16

~~for~~ bearing trees at this point. but they had been so badly disfigured by fire that the marks were not distinguishable. the S. E. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 997.

I then ran North. at 870 m. crossed Esperanza Creek. at 1027 m. the N. E. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 997. from which a Live Oak. m<sup>z</sup> b. c<sup>o</sup> 70 W. 2 m. (This tree is the one claimed by Mr Winsor. Surveyor for Geo. D. Robbins and J. J. & C. J. Dull as the original bearing tree. and I am satisfied that it is the case). The stump of another Live Oak b. S 84. 1/2 W. 1 varas - I then ran West. on South line of Omry c<sup>o</sup> 1001. at 200 m. crossed a creek at a lot of Live Oaks and a pond. at 1830 m. crossed Esperanza Creek at or the Barredon road crossing. at 2000 m. found original bearing trees -

In the foregoing runs from the S. E. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 997 to the S. W. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 1001. I find a number of 368 varas in Latitude. and of 237 varas in Departure.

Having established the aforesaid Omrys. on the ground. by the original corners and line trees found. and as Omrys c<sup>o</sup> 982. 985 and 986 in McMullen Co. are a part of the same Block. surveyed at the same time. by the same Surveyor. and connected therewith by the walls of their field notes. I went to the S. E. cor. Omry c<sup>o</sup> 990. which is N. W. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 988. and N. E. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 989. and ran North. with the West line of Omry c<sup>o</sup> 988. at 40 m. crossed Esperanza Creek. at 1900 m. put a stake for S. W. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 988. I then ran East. at 1260 m. crossed Esperanza Creek. at 1900 m. put a stake for S. E. corner Omry c<sup>o</sup> 988. on the East side of Gang Creek. which at this point is only the size of a branch - I then ran East 1260 m. to the N. W. corner for Omry c<sup>o</sup> 986. near a small branch. upon which there are Live Oaks. but the original tree gone. I then ran North. with the West boundary line of Omry c<sup>o</sup> 986. at 250 m. crossed Creek. at 580 yds

in. croped in Creek. at 950 in. the S. W. corner said Survey  
No 986. I then ran East 530 varas. and put stake for  
N. W. corner Survey No 985. on the West side of Esper-  
anza Creek. I then ran South. at 1344 in. put stake  
South of road for N. E. corner Survey No 982. Then  
East at 950 in. Esperanza Creek. at 1344 in. the N. E. cor.  
Survey No 982. a stake in field. from which the beginning  
corner of Survey No 981 established by Brown bis North  
141 in. I then ran South. at 124 in. North bank Esper-  
anza Creek (a Lake) at 264 varas the South bank of  
same. at 1344 in. put stake for S. E. corner Survey No  
982 in name Sebastian Rippstein.


I do hereby certify that the foregoing is the true
