

Field Notes of a connecting line
in La Salle Co. as run and measured
by Dennis Corwin, a deputy Surveyor
of Texas District, between the 1st day
of Sept. 1875 and the 1st day of
1875.

Beginning on the East corner
of Survey No. 2 in the name of J. Portinix
situated on Yahvey Creek about 5 miles
S.W. from the present crossing of the
Rio. Rio. Said corner is on the South
side of the creek and West of the road
leading to F. H. Emell near the Ranch
of Mr. Wank and is on a stake with
a few small stones. This corner I ver-
ified by connecting with other corners of
the same block of work.

From said corner of No. 2, I ran a
line, S. 30° W. 33,180 varas to the South
margin of the Nueces River thence
N. 89° E. 4,700 varas to the upper corner
Survey No. 289 in the name of M. Farn.
thence East 7,430 varas thence
South 18,100 varas to the N.E. corner of
a Survey on the South bank of Nueces
in the name of Pease No.

N.B. This last connection was made by
running and measuring a random line
counter 29528

and then calculating for Smithing
and Costing,

Beginning on the point where it
first struck the Nueces river which
is N. 89° E. 470, or from the upper corner of
No. 289, thence, West, 11,460 varas and
North ~~14,460~~ varas to the lower corner on
the Nueces of Survey No. 12, file S-8457
which corner is at the lower corner of
a pasture fence

A B. This connection was run by
the meanders of the River and then
calculated by the traverse table,
