

REPORT OF LOCATION OF S W BOUNDARY LINES OF SURVEYS 60,
Jose Robles; 63,64,65,67, P. S. Gleises; 68, Kachar
Roby; 71, J. W. Grice; 72, Geo. Gurrkell; 73, Andrew
Eagan; 75, Wm. Condon; 78, Lewis Bray, in La Salle County

On field notes to Surv. 680 Cert. ¹¹⁴⁶ Call No. 10 says
Thence, with the S. W. Bdy line of Surv. 79, S. Summings, S. 45 deg
W 369 vrs. to pasture fence of W. C. Irvin. Call No. 11 says
Thence, with said fence S. 7 deg. 109 vrs. Call No. 12 says
Thence, S. 8 deg. E. 599 vrs. There is a place in the W. C. Irvin
fence where there is a turn of approximately one degree. Taking this
point on the Irvin pasture fence as being on the line of Surv. 79, I
ran a line N. 45 deg. E. to the Frio River and found the distance to be
2534.4 vrs.

In field notes of Surv. No. 681 Cert. No. ¹¹⁴⁶ Call No. 11 says
Thence, N. 7 deg. W. 109 vrs. to S.E. Bdy line of Surv. 79. Call No. 12
says Thence, S. 45 deg. W. 448 vrs. to S. Cor of Surv. 79. Taking
448 vrs. plus the measured distance from fence to river would make
the S E Bdy Line of Surv. No. 79 2983.4 vrs. The length of this line
as called in the patent is 2564. From this it seems that this is not
the proper location for S E line of Surv. No. 79. However, I crossed
four surveys running in to river on each line and searched for bearing
trees but could find none.

The fence between the Irvin and Dull ranches is supposed to run S. 32
deg. W. (Located by J. N. Daniel, County Surveyor, La Salle County)
from the N.W. or upper corner of Survey 56 Cert. ¹⁷⁴ No. to the S.E.
corner of same survey. I took the place where this fence connects with
the S. bank of Frio River as the N.W. Cor of Surv. 56 and ran a line
across the surveys as indicated on the accompnaying sketch and searched
at all corners but found no big trees. After crossing the surveys up
as far as S. E. line of Surv. 79, I failed to reach the line previous-
ly run for S.E. line of 79, by 568.4 vrs.

It appears from the sketch of Surveys by Mr. Prandy that he has used
the upper location and I have used the lower one, for if the upper
location is used it puts the S.W. lines of all river surveys about 576
vrs. nearer the river or to the N. E. Thus, making the area to be
covered by Surveys 576, 577, 578 and 904, greater than if lower
location is used.

This survey is based on the assumption that the fence between the
Irvin and Dull ranches is on upper corner of Survey 56 and lower corner
of 58 at the Frio River.

Beginning at a fence corner also pointed post for S.W. cor. Surv. No. 8, J. Poitevant, from whence a 20" Mes. mkd. X brs N. 63 deg. E. 139 vrs. (Original big trees were two comas when survey for patent was made, this Mes. was given as a witness tree and the two comas were said to be dead and on the ground at that time).

Thence, N. 65 deg. E. along a fence 565.9' to fence corner and pointed post for N.E. Cor. of Surv. No. 5 (No big trees found here)

Thence, S. 25 deg. E. 375 vrs. to fence corner for S.W. Cor. Surv. 673, H. & O. B. N.W. Cor. 32, J. Poitevant. Original big prong Mes. 8" brs. N. 50 W. 23.4 vrs, Prong Mes. 12" from same roots mkd. ϕ . Thence, N. 65 deg. E. along a fence 5012 vrs. to a pointed post, said post is S. 65 deg. W. 27.7 vrs. from fence corner. This post I have taken for S. E. Cor. of Sur. 674, H. & O. B. continuing on 417.6 vrs for N. E. Cor. of Surv. No. 675, H. & O.B.

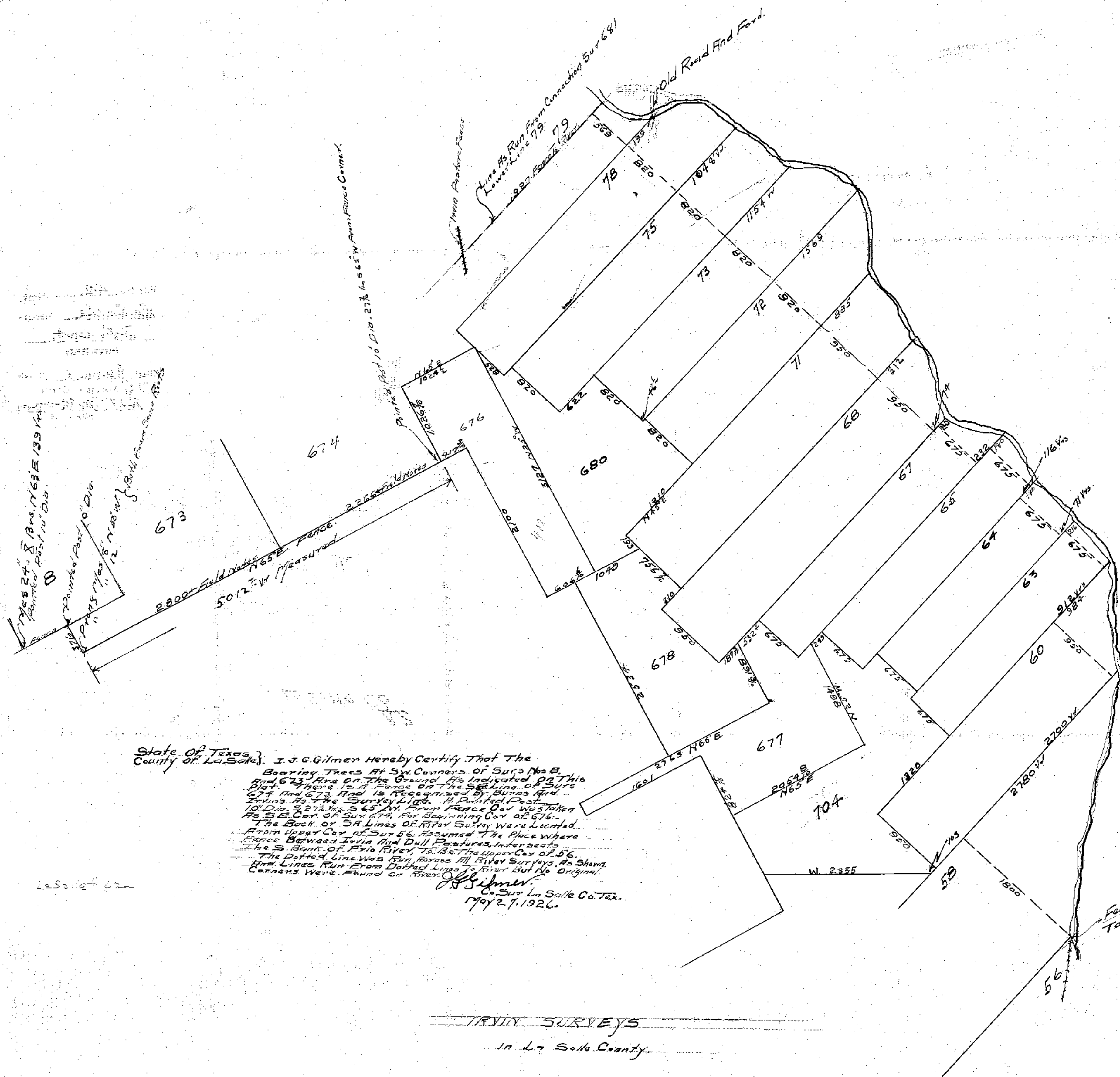
