OFFICE MEMORANDUM - MR. WALLACE

RE: W. W. Alderman Survey 148½,
S.F. 14828, La Salle County

I have examined the following documents: La Salle County Rld. Sk. 12 by D. W. Cobb; La Salle County Rolled Sk. 15 by Frank J. Schorp; corrected field notes and sketch of E. W. Alderman Survey 146 surveyed by John M. Daniel November 1 and 2, 1904; John M. Daniel report on resurvey of Atascosa County School Land Survey 300.

I have made several working sketches of the area involved using the above described documents and the original field notes and corrected field notes of all the adjoining surveys. These working sketches are now filed in the La Salle County Rolled Sketch File. This matter has also been discussed with Mr. Cobb and Mr. Schorp on their visits to this office.

Mr. Cobb and Mr. Schorp are in agreement as to the location of the SE corner of Sec. 21, T. & N.O. R.R., and the SW corner and the SE corner of Sec. 109, A.B. & M. Blk. D. These corners were also located by Mr. Daniel in 1904. Beginning at the SE corner of Sec. 109 and giving Sec. 146 its call distances as in the patented field notes, the south line of Sec. 146 will be contingent with the north line of Sec. 111, A.B. & M., as located by Mr. Daniel in his resurvey of Atascosa County School Land No. 300 in 1904.

Mr. Cobb gives the east line of Sec. 146 along the west line of Sections 17 and 18, a distance of 1168 varas in his Rld. Sk. No. 12, and in November of 1947, he submitted corrected field notes for Sec. 146 giving this east line a distance of 1371 varas and decreasing the north and south distances of Sections 19 and 112 — these field notes were not accepted by this office.

Mr. Schorp submits Rld. Sk. No. 15 as his evidence of having re-established the corners and lines of Sections 17 and 21 as located by Mr. Daniel in his report to the Court in Cause No. 775, styled County of Atascosa vs. E. W. Alderman.

In Rld. Sk. 12, Mr. Cobb shows a break in the common corner at the NE corner of Sec. 21 and the NW corner of Atascosa County School Land No. 300.



Mr. Cobb submitted a working sketch on which he had located the NE corner of Sec. 10, Heirs of B. W. Wheeler, from which corner Mr. Daniel had identified and run a connecting line to the SE corner of Sec. 21. In delineating Mr. Daniel's lines on Mr. Cobb's working sketch, the south lines of Sections 112, 19 and 17 are located in the approximate position as shown by Mr. Schorp in his sketch filed as Rld. Sk. 15.

I have delineated the work of Mr. Schorp, Mr. Cobb and Mr. Daniel on an office sketch which is filed as Rld. Sk. 17, and it is my conclusion that a slight conflict exists between Survey 148½ and A.B. & M. Survey 111, and Survey 148½ and A.C.H. & B. Survey 114.
