Dear sir

I proceeded upon the ground to examine the surounding surveys of Josephus Meeks Beginning at the beginning corner of L Rucker survey Thence S 71° W instead of ~~N~~ 21 83° W it was 21 21° W Thence S 19° E instead of 17 28° W it was 16 18° W Thence S 71° W instead of 17 30° W it was 19 06° W Thence S 19° E with F Potthast survey instead of 16 28° W it was 17 10° W to the N E corner of said Potthast survey

I then proceeded to the N W corner of James Nimmie Survey and instead of the <sup>of Wm T Charles survey</sup> N E corner being 20 7° W S 19° W it was 7 5° W S 19° E from it and on the west boundary line of the Nimmie Survey Surveyed January 26<sup>th</sup> 1860
