 on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August 1835.  
 Situated in Liberty County  
 on the waters of Cedar  
 Bayou.

Beginning at the North East corner of a Survey  
 of a League and a quarter of land made  
 for Luis Latham, being the Survey which includes  
 under the "Pecan Island,"  
 Thence N 85° E.

2500 Varas set the 2<sup>nd</sup> corner - a stake in prairie.

Thence N 5° W

2500 Varas. Set the 3<sup>rd</sup> corner in prairie

Thence S 85° W.

2500 Varas - Set 4<sup>th</sup> corner in prairie

Thence S 5° E.

2500 Varas to the place of beginning -

November 11<sup>th</sup> 1858 -

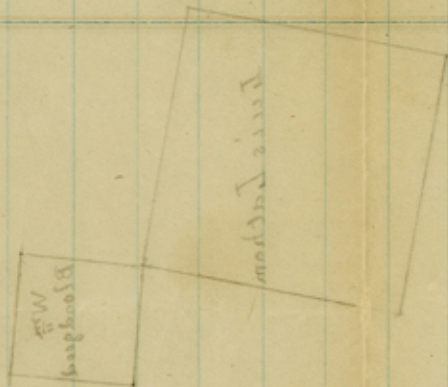
