

Gaulebeck Texas April 28/83.
To The Hon W. C. Walsh,
Austin Texas.

Sir:

I herewith send you a statement of facts, as found by a recent survey made about the 24th day of March 1883, regarding the survey in the name of Alex. W. Patten by me made Sept 7th 1880, and the R Rutledge Sur. The Field of the 1st named survey are recorded in Book 13 Page 534. I represent to you in this statement the survey made March 24, or about there, 1st. I began on the west line of A. Gilliam survey at Christmas Creek. With the calls of the Uhas Rockett. Thence from the creek N 30 W with said Gilliam at 1140 pass Gilliam's N W corner. (By taking Rockett's call to pass Gilliam 3345 - vs, from its call for the creek 4050, will show the corner of Gilliam to be 405 - vs from the creek, instead of this, we find it - to be 1140 (vs. 3.)

Continuing N 30 W - at 4050 (from the creek.)

to a point on the Prairie, ~~that~~-
which, by the call of said Rockett, for
the creek, should be its N.E. corner.
At this point we find no bear-
ings. From this point to run
through S60W (red dotted line
E, d c.-) we find no line marks,
at 5099 a point on the east
side of creek, but, to continue
this line to a point on the west
side of the creek that will inter-
sect the line A, a c. or by inter-
secting C e + c e, - from this
point a line running N30W
will by distance stop at "a" the
N.E. corner of M Polk, But to
go again to "E" and run the dis-
tance called to pass Gilliam,
435-01'S or 3345-01'S from Gilliam
N30W - a point at "F", - Running
from this point S60W we find
no marks. Continuing from
"F" N30W 2000'S to "H", Hence
S60W at 894-01'S to "h", a point
on high Prairie, G + h are both
on open prairie, no bearings
found at either place, but
to continue from "h" S60W
at 400-01'S cross a small branch
at "D", Continuing this line
S60W to "C", about 100-01'S on
west bank side of creek.

This is the North line of S + T C
no 21 + State see no 22. We find
this line marked.

Commencing at C we go N 30
W 3481 vs to the NE corner of
M Polk. This is the corner referred
to in my certificate dated
Oct 29/1880. where I said "Old
bearings found, & determine
this as the Polk by running
S 60 W to the creek and finding
an old line well marked,
and this point fits the dis-
tance to the creek S 60 W with
usual accuracy. The bearings
were standing & marked when
the survey was made Sept 17/80.
but they are now cut down,"

The Polk & Rutledge call for the
same trees, except Rutledge
calls one to be 42 vs. while Polk
calls for 12. Yet Rutledge calls
to pass Polk. at 1780 vs. We con-
tinue this line 722 vs to "A"
which is 4203 from "C".

Thence, N 60 E from this point
we come to the E corner of State
section no 16. Thence we go
to the SW corner of Bro Robinson.

a 1/4th whence a Mesquite tree
N 60 E 104 0/13. The Mesquite is
standing and marked, it is
also the bearing to the west cor-
ner of state section No 14. Thence
from Robinett, S 60 W 93 0/10
The said corner of sec 14.
From this corner S 30 E 403 0/10
we intersect the line
"A" - "B"
