There are two errors in the aed
work. To wit. No. 496. M. Arisinga-
is about 4 or 5 hundred rods broader
N. & S. than the field notes make it.
And. 2^d - the North line of No. 493-
W- K. Simpson. Runs N. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. to Reach
the N. E. cor. of sd No. 493

The result of this is; that Survey No.
697. - J. Faund, F. Bendt. & No. 5 & 6
B. S. & M. - all of which plot from or
conspound with A.W. corner of No. 496-
are all North - (further North)
of No. 493 than the field notes of said
Survey, otherwise make them-

connecting line
Run from the North
Bdy. line of Smoky
N. 493 Wm R.
Simpson to the
Auringa South line of Smoky
No. 497 No. 5 + 6, Butt Seal
+ Morris.

Began at the N.W. corner of Smoky
N. 493, Wm R. Simpson, found both
bearing trees as called for in the
field notes of sd. N. 493.

Thence S-740 ^{W. and Lapsed}
^{the S.W. corner of} forty one mrs. South of Smoky N.-
Elizabeth Hoy Pumption. Found
the corner of sd. Pumption with
bearing trees as called for.

I then changed course to
A 86 1/2 East +

Began at sd. S.W. corner of E Hoy
And Ran A 86 1/2 East and at 744 mrs
found S.E. cor. of said Pumption with
bs. trees as called for. I then discov-
ered the true course of sd. North line
of sd. N. 493 to be A 86 1/2 E. found
that said line was a plainly
marked line. had been Ran and
marked on that course by R. F.
Rowntree - a former Smoyer &

Began at sd S.E. corner of Hoy, & Ran
North and at 1140 vs. found N.E.
corner of Hoy. br. trees as called for.
Hence ~~W. 493~~ to S.W. corner of No.
6. & found S.W. corner of No. 6. br. trees
as called for.

Then began again at S.W. cor.
of E. Hoy & Ran North to N.W. corner
of same & found the distance to
be 1180 vs. found br. trees as called
for.

Total of which I determine as
follows - To wit:

That the distance from N.W. corner
of No. 493 to a point due north of
Said corner & due west from
the S.W. cor. of No. 6. (which is in W.
bdy line of an abandoned plantation
in name of Isaac Montgomery) is
1220 vs. the

Distance from S.W. cor. of - Hoy to
N.W. cor. same 1180 vs.

The distance from S.E. cor.
to N.E. cor. same 1140 vs.

The distance from S.E. cor.
of G.W. Ellis to N.E. cor. same 1107
vs.

The petition from A. E. an No. 493
to S. E. an. & B. and 2292 vs.

That said North line of No. 493 Run
A. 86 in S. instead of due East,

That the North bdy line of said
Preemption Hoy & Ellis is on the
South bdy line of M. S. & C. B. S. & H.

That said ~~fact~~ Preemptions
are probably laid off on the ground
but are incorrect as to distances
of North & South lines & as to
course of South lines ~~are also incor-~~
~~rect~~.
