Hoy Preemption & J. W. Ellis Preemption
Also field notes of a connecting line
Run from North line No. 493 to South
line of Nos. 5, 6, B. S. & M.

There are two errors in the old
work. To wit. No. 496. M. Arisinga-
is about 4 or 5 hundred rods broader
N. & S. than the field notes make it.
And 2^d - The North line of No. 493 -
W. K. Simpson. Runs N. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. to Reach
the N. E. cor. of sd No. 493

The Result of this is, that Surveys No.
697. - J. Faund, F. Berndt. & No. 5 & 6
B. S. & M. - all of which plat from - or
correspond with N. W. corner of No. 496 -

are all North - (farther North -)
of No. 493 than the field notes of said
Surveys otherwise make them -

Began at the N.W. corner of Survey
 No. 493, Wm K Simpson, found both
 bearings true as called for in the
 field notes of sd. No. 493.

Thence S. 74° 00' W. and laid
 forty one rods South of ^{the S.W. corner of} Survey No. -
 Elizabeth Hoy Preemption. Found
 the corner of sd. Preemption with
 bearings true as called for.

I then changed course to
 N 86 1/2° East +

Began at sd. S.W. corner of E Hoy
 and ran N 86 1/2° East and at 744 rods
 found S.E. cor. of said Preemption with
 bearings true as called for. I then discov-
 ered the true course of sd North line
 of sd. No. 493 to be N 86 1/2° E. found
 that said line was a plainly
 marked line. had been run and
 marked on that course by R. F.
 Rowntree - a former Surveyor of

Lano county. That the corner corner
to wit N. 86 1/2° East. was the true corner
from N.W. to N.E. corner of Said No.
493.

Began at sd S.E. corner of Hoy, & Ran
North and at 1140 vs. found N.E.
corner of Hoy. Br. Thus as called for
thence W. ~~900~~ to S.W. corner of No.
6. & found S.W. corner of No. 6. Br. Thus
as called for.

Then Began again at S.W. cor.
of E. Hoy & Ran North to N.W. corner
of same & found the distance to
be 1180 vs. found Br. Thus as called
for.

Formal of which I determine as
follows - To wit:

That the distance from N.W. corner
of No. 493. to a point due west of
said corner & due west from
the S.W. cor. of No. 6. (which is the W.
bdy line of an abandoned Preemption
in name of Isaac Montgomery) is
1220 vs. the

distance from S.W. cor. of - Hoy to
N.W. cor. same 1180 vs.

The distance from S.E. cor. Hoy
to N.E. cor. same 1140 vs.

The distance from S.E. cor.
of G.W. Ellis to N.E. cor. same 1100
vs.

The distance from N.E. cor. No. 493
to S.E. cor. H. Bend 2292 vs.

That said North line of No. 493 Runs
N. 86° E. instead of due East,

That the North bdy lines of said
Presumptions Hoy + Ellis is on the
South bdy lines of No. 5 + 6, B, S, + M.

That said ~~fact~~ Presumptions
are properly laid off on the ground
but an inconv. as to distances
of North + South lines + as to
course of South lines ~~are also in-~~
~~conv.~~
