Dear Sir:

Judge J. A. Drane of Pecos, Texas, showed me a letter from you in which you requested that I submit a sketch showing how I had tied Section 22, Blk. 55, Tswp. 2, to the New Mexico-Texas State Line. I am attaching a sketch showing the distance to be 20,900 varas. Several years ago I established the corners of Sections 3 and 4 on the foregoing State Line by putting in a 2 inch iron post and a rock mound.

I trust that this sketch will complete everything for Mr. H. A. Lindley with the exception of Section 98, Blk. 33, H&TC Survey, which is the most confusing survey that I have ever made in this part of the State. As soon as possible after the first of the year, wheather permitting, I will go to that section and make an elaborate survey, chaining the distances to established corners both East and West as well as running completely around the section.

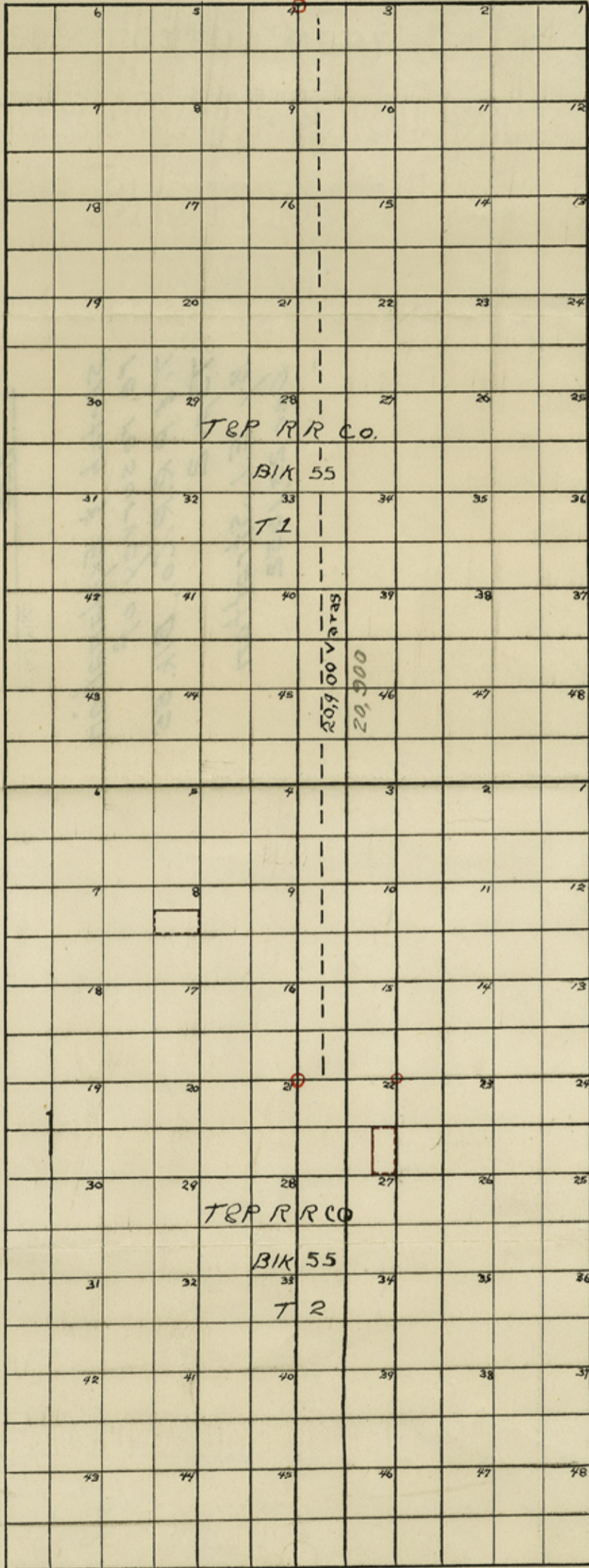
