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Dear Sir:-

I could not get a tracing made showing the Kokernot ranch in Lubbook county in time to carry with me to your office so my transitman, Jeff Williams, made the tracing after I left and tried to get it to me by special delivery. I was called to Fort Worth a day earlier than I expected, so the map came too late for me to explain. Under the circumstances it is necessarily a skeleton map, showing only the connections to the SW of 1 Block A; to the original corners on the ground including the abandoned corners which were supposed to be on located land, and which are shown in one of Mr. Powels depositions. While I traced these corners for the information that they may give, you will notice , on the map, that I construct from the corners described in the original field notes and swing the courses east and west to conform with the original corners, and I place all the north and south lines N. 0°40' W., keeping them parallel. The sketch shows the Base I have placed on the south and West of Block S, also the connection made to the Sw of 732, also the connection made to the Lubbook corner, and the way all of this will plat out with my work in Blocks RG and C. 4 139 One connection that Jeff omitted is from the original

On the first of March I wish to go on the ground to complete the Kokernot Ranch, which I am now writing about, and I hope that this disconnected report will enable you to look into what I have found on the ground and for you to instruct me XXXXX how to go on and complete the work. Please take a blueprint of the map which was mailed to me by special delivery, in care of the Land Office, and send the original back to me with the instructions. If the map is not sufficient(I havent seen the tracing) send it back with instructions as to what is needed. Please look into this matter as soon as you can conveniently, so that all points will be fully determined by the 25" of this month.
