Field notes of a connection between Double Lakes  
in Lynn County, Texas, and, the New Mexican  
line and West boundary of Yoakum County, Texas.  
Beginning at a monument and circular trench  
eight feet in diameter between the Double Lakes,  
whence West edge of East Lake bears East 605 varas,  
(nearest point to East Lake 570 varas, South end of  
East Lake 700 varas) most Northern point of West  
Lake bears West about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of one mile (North East edge  
of West Lake bears  $S 20^{\circ} W. 300$  varas) the North East  
corner of Survey  $N^{\circ} 319$  Block  $N^{\circ} 3$ . Thence North  
six miles + 177 varas to the North East corner of Sur-  
vey  $N^{\circ} 158$ . Thence West (14) fourteen miles to  
an earth mound and two large pits, (very old)  
Thence West, magnetic variation  $10^{\circ} 19' East$ , 1906  $\frac{1}{2}$   
varas to an earth mound and two stones, whence  
old Spring at the North end of Rich Lake bears  $S 6^{\circ} W.$   
689 varas. Thence West, magnetic variation  $11^{\circ} 19' East$ ,  
(24) twenty four miles + 669  $\frac{1}{2}$  varas, to the North  
East corner of Survey  $N^{\circ} 16$ , John H. Gibson Block D.  
Terry County, Texas. Thence North five (5) miles and  
140 varas to large stone set in ground with two  
stones leaning against it, whence stone marked X  
set in ground on sand knoll brs  $N 14^{\circ} 04' E. 5 \frac{1}{2}$  miles,  
another stone marked X set in ground on sand knoll  
bears  $S 58^{\circ} 52' W. 126$  varas, and another stone marked X  
set in ground on sand knoll brs North  $74^{\circ} 16' East$   
210 varas, the North East cor of Survey  $N^{\circ} 21$ , John  
H. Gibson Block D. Terry County. Thence South (11)  
eleven miles + 329 varas to the North East corner of

1 Survey N<sup>o</sup> 10, John H. Gibson Block D. Thence West  
2 three miles to the North East corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 1.

3 John H. Gibson Block D. construct earth monument  
4 with quart tin can buried in it, and dig circular  
5 trench ten feet in diameter on point of sandy ridge,  
6 whence Lake basin bears N. E. 300 varas, another monument  
7 (with tin can buried in it,) and circular trench 12 feet  
8 in diameter dug in firm ground in small basin bears  
9 South 224 varas, another earth monument and circular  
10 trench 11 feet in diameter on North bank of Sulphur  
11 Draw bears South 6 miles + 1494 varas.

12 Thence West (13) thirteen miles to the N. W. corner of  
13 Survey N<sup>o</sup> 393. John H. Gibson Block D. construct  
14 earth monument and circular trench 13 feet in dia  
15 in firm ground. Thence West (3) three miles to N. W.

16 corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 396 John H. Gibson Block D.  
17 Thence North (2) two miles + 620 varas to the N. W. cor

18 of Sur N<sup>o</sup> 340 same Block. construct earth monument  
19 and circular trench 12½ feet in diameter in firm  
20 ground. Thence West (6) six miles + 1744 varas to the  
21 New Mexico and Texas Boundary, construct monument  
22 and semi-circular trench 4½ varas in diameter  
23 the N. W. cor of Sur N<sup>o</sup> 347 same block.

24 (Note: The magnetic variation of Block D is six  
25 minutes less than the variation from true North.)

26 Thence South 1° 03' W. with the line of New Mexico, at  
27 1931 varas construct monument and semi-circular trench  
28 five varas in diameter in firm soil for N. W. cor of Survey  
29 N<sup>o</sup> 358 same block. Thence South 1° 03' W. 1931 varas  
30 to N. W. cor of Sur N<sup>o</sup> 403 same block, construct monument  
31 and semi-circular trench 5 varas in diameter in sandy  
32 soil. Thence S 1° 03' W. with line of New Mexico 1901

varas to N.W. cor of Sur N<sup>o</sup> 414, construct monument  
and semi-circular trench  $5\frac{1}{2}$  varas in diameter in sandy  
soil. Thence S  $1^{\circ} 03' W.$  1901 varas to N.W. cor of Sur  
N<sup>o</sup> 455 same block, construct monument and semi-  
circular trench  $5\frac{7}{10}$  varas in diameter in sandy soil,  
Thence S  $1^{\circ} 03' W.$  with line of New Mexico at 385 varas  
earth monument and circular trench 16 feet in diameter,  
the same being 81 miles + 655 varas North from the South  
East corner of New Mexico, at 1901 varas construct mon-  
ument and semi-circular trench  $5\frac{1}{2}$  varas in diameter,  
Thence S  $1^{\circ} 03' W.$  with line of New Mexico at 1901 varas  
construct mound and semi-circular trench  $5\frac{1}{2}$  varas  
in diameter, at 3802 varas construct monument and  
semi-circular trench  $5\frac{1}{2}$  varas in diameter, at 5703 varas  
construct monument and semi-circular trench  $5\frac{1}{2}$  varas  
in diameter, at 7604 varas construct monument with  
glass bottle ~~in the center~~ trench 5 varas in diameter in firm ground, at 8603 varas  
earth monument covered with stone, and circular trench  
16 feet in dia, (the same being (76) seventy six miles North  
from the S.E. corner of New Mexico) at 9505 varas set stone  
 $1' \times 1' \times 2\frac{1}{2}'$ , mkd T + M.L. in ground and built earth  
monument with another stone  $6" \times 15" \times 2\frac{1}{2}'$ , leaning against  
it and dug circular trench 8 ft in dia in firm ground,  
at 11333 varas cross road running South East, at 11406 varas  
construct earth monument and semi-circular trench 5 varas  
in dia in firm ground. Thence East at 270 varas construct  
mound and four large pits in firm ground, the same being  
42 varas East from the N.W. cor of Sur N<sup>o</sup> 660 Block D.
