North 31 Varas Thence North  $45^{\circ}$  West ascending low rocky hill 2688 Varas to 3 small Stone on North slope of hill

15<sup>th</sup> Thence East at 424.8 Varas cross a fence 1900.8 Varas a  
point in East edge of Sarghum field

16<sup>th</sup> Thence East 1900.8 Varas to a point a pine stake br. south

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Thence South 1900.8 Varas a point
- 4<sup>th</sup> Thence South at 133 Varas cross Takaka and Garya county road 1900.8 Varas point in low flat
- 5<sup>th</sup> Thence South crossing a draw 1900.8 Varas to a point
- 6<sup>th</sup> Thence South 1900.8 Varas to a point  
Thence South 134 Varas to the S. E. corner of Survey No. 557 T. & N. O. Ry. Co. (the battle corner)

Beginning again at the North East corner of the Wm H. Cabbs Survey in Garya county

- 1<sup>st</sup> Thence West crossing a deep gulch at 1819 varas pass 7 varas North of old stone mound 1900.8 Varas to old stone mound
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Thence West crossing deep gulch in canon with running water and ascending cap rock of plains 1900.8 Varas point in S.W. Edge of dry lake
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Thence West 1900.8 Varas point
- 4<sup>th</sup> Thence West 1900.8 Varas point
- 5<sup>th</sup> Thence West crossing North End of a tank at two Wind Mills 1900.8 Varas point
- 6<sup>th</sup> Thence West 1900.8 Varas to a point
- 7<sup>th</sup> Thence West 1900.8 Varas to an earthen mound and 2 pits
- 8<sup>th</sup> Thence West 1900.8 Varas to a cross dug in ground

9<sup>th</sup> Thence West 939.6 Varas cross the West Curry Lamb  
pasture fence 1900.8 Varas to a pine stake set in ground

Thence South entering basin at 191 Varas cross fence  
in basin and ascending low hill at 1067 Varas pass  
a stone mound on top of hill 1900.8 Varas a stake

Thence South 1900.8 Varas to a point

Thence South 1900.8 Varas to a point

Thence South crossing a fence 1900.8 Varas a point

Thence South 830 Varas to a point <sup>on connection line from the</sup> double lake corner

Thence West 427 Varas to a point from which Wind Mill  
kasting set in Earth mound and 4 pits bears South 97 Varas  
this brings the connections from Double Lakes and bottle  
corners and the Cat's Camp all to a close at this point
