R.R. Co. on gravel ridge. Thenee N.  $14^{\circ}34'$  W. crossing two drains  
course west 1900.8 Varas to a Stake from which a stone mound brs.  
N.  $24^{\circ}15'$  E. 11 Varas Thenee N.  $14^{\circ}34'$  West at 765 Vrs. cross
