Dear Sir:-

Your letter of July 12th, relative to the above files received, and at your request I have prepared a map of the area which I am enclosing.

Doctor Timmons also owns section 604, and at the time I made several other surveys in that territory not shown on this map.

You will note that the north line of section 527 and on east in that tier, are 34.4 varas north of the north line of section 528 and on west for a few miles, this accounts for the difference of your patent records and the actual distances found on the ground, for the given line between sections 528 and 559 on the west and sections 557 and 527 on the east. My east line of sections 604, 558, 557 and 527 compares fairly well with the west lines of sections 605-558-555 and 556 by Twichell giving the disance north from the East-West north line of sections west from Camp Branch up to the center of the paved highway, which was set center line over marked lines by Twichell on Post Company lands.

I surveyed the excess acreage within the bounds of the property lines of the lands owned by Dr. Timmons, which he is willing to buy and pay for under the law governing such sales.
