Pardon delay in carrying out my promise to send you a sketch, showing actual conditions of surveys around Sims Bayou, in Marion County; but pressure of business has kept me on the move since I saw you. Herewith I enclose a hastily constructed plat, but which outlines correctly a part of my work in that county in 1910. All the distances given are as actually measured; and Sims Bayou is sketched in from close meanders, except from the E. Williams N.E.cor. up to the N.E.cor. of the largest F. Poyer tract.



