Block S was set up holding the South line call of said Block S of West 1375 varas on the East-West line that was set up from the South shore and the Texas-Louisiana line of Caddo Lake Subdivision. Then North from said East-West line until it intersects 173.09 contour line, being the North shore line of said Caddo Lake Subdivision set by Arthur D. Kidder, in 1914.
