- (1) $3\frac{3}{10}$ acres Surveyed for Mr Glendening on S.E. Cor. Sec. 12, P. 37. T. 2. South. in Midland County, Texas. For Public School house lot. Surveyed Sept. 1, 1913.
- (2) A survey made for A. M. Woodard in Sec. 133. P. A. Containing 450 acres. being one of those small sections about 14 miles N.W. of Stanton, the County site.
