I am enclosing the field notes of Sur. No. 1, T. C. R. R. Co. I entered them of record in Llano County Surveyors' Records. I figure that the acreage in Sur. No. 1, in Llano County to be nearly 91 acres. The connection with the South line of No. 1, with the County line is 268 vrs. West of its S. E. corner, and with the North line of same is 272 vrs. From this you can check in on the acreage.

I am also sending a large sketch of Section No. 2, showing the subdivisions supposed to be made with regards to the fence lines as they are on the ground. I think that this will be sufficient for all purposes however if there is anything else you wish information about just let me know and I will be glad to furnish what you wish.


