

Matagorda Texas May 10th 1890.

Field Notes of connecting lines run in Matagorda County in April and May 1890 -

Variation 9° 15' E.

Beginning at the old stake marked "O.B." for West corner of pre-emption No. 7 in name of A. W. Mangum, on the Southeast line of the David Fenton league. Thence a line was run (with Variation 8° 15' E.) N. 62° E. 17 1/2 vs. along a ledge, and set a stake. Thence (with Variation 9° 15' E.) N. 28° W. 5000. vs and set a stake marked "D". Thence S. 62° W. ab 1860 vs timber at 4658 vs. lake, or mud flat, ab 4732. vs bank of Colorado river. Thence from the stake marked "D" N. 74° 45' E. 501. vs to the West corner of Pierce and Sullivan "Duncan Ranch" pasture (corner of fence S. 45° E. and N. 27° 30' E.) Then running at a T. R.R. iron post for a corner of Matagorda and Wharton Counties, and the South corner of Edwards league, a large live oak tree marked X bears N. 51° 15' W. 4 L. vs. and another large live oak tree marked X bears S. 58° 30' W. 94. vs. Thence S. 45° W. 17 1/2 vs. Thence S. 45° E. 252 vs to "Duncan Ranch pasture" fence, at 11 vs N. 45° E. of its corner, at 1439. vs. Thence S. 45° W. 1171. vs at this point the West corner of Pierce and Sullivan "Duncan Ranch" pasture fence bears S. 45° W. 2891. vs. Thence S. 45° E. 1223. vs set a stake, from which a large lone pecan tree bears N. 66° W. 169 1/2 vs. Thence N. 45° E. 184 vs. lone pecan tree bears S. 78° W. Thence S. 45° E. 221 vs. a lone tree on Beno Bayou bears S 18° E. and also one bears S. 4 1/2° W. Thence S. 45° E. 1779 1/2 vs. small lone tree bears S. 20° W. Thence S. 45° W. 888. vs. Thence S. 45° E. at 688 vs Beno Bayou, at 708 vs across same, at 1181 vs. lone tree S. 45° E. (and one br. N. 69 1/2 W) at (1944 vs more) or 3125. vs. Thence S. 45° W. 1468. vs to corner of "Duncan Ranch pasture". Thence (with

Variation $9^{\circ} 30'$ E.) S 45° E. at 281 γ or South cor. of "Duncan Ranch pasture". at 321 γ or N.E. of East cor. of Bailey and Johnson pasture, at 4166 or set flag. Then Beginning at the South and West corners of the first ^(and second)_(with variation $9^{\circ} 30'$) small tracts of the A. Rawls league. Thence N. 45° W. 235.00. and set a stake S. 45° W. of the Northwest line of fence on the 200 acres which joins the three small tracts. Then Beginning at the edge of the timber, on an old ditch where there is a line of Bois d'arc trees. Thence S. 45° W. Flaggs to a point in the prairie. Thence S 45° E. 250.00 to the stake set at N. 45° W. 235.00 Thence S. 45° W. 705 or Thence ^(Variation $9^{\circ} 30'$) N. 45° W. at 250.00 set a stake, at 291 or to the flag set at S. 45° E. 4166 or.

Variation $9^{\circ} 30'$ E.

Beginning at the N. W. corner of Philip Kestler tract on the East line of Ewing tract, 8 $\frac{5}{7}$ or West of Buck Bayou, a live oak tree marked "K" bears N. 79° E. 1.00. Thence North 18 or to South corner of N.^o.1. Thence North 2076 or to a post for N. W. corner of said N.^o.1. Thence East 2348.00. Thence S 45° E. 344 γ Thence S 45° E. 500.00. Thence N. 45° E. 169 or to South-West line of John Duncan tract. Thence S 45° E. 477.00 to a large live oak post at the South corner of said J. Duncan survey, the South corner of the J. M. Duke league bears N. 45° E. 2033.00. Thence N. 45° W. 391 γ .00 along an old ditch and fence row, and set a stake from which a lone live oak tree on Buck Bayou bears S. 82° W. and a stump bears S. $30^{\circ} 10'$ W. said ditch and fence row continues straight on N. 45° W. the whole distance of the South-west line of the J. Duncan N.^o.3. Thence N. 45° E. at 1924.00 the South ^{West line} corner of J. Maynard tract (*) bears N. 45° W. 144.00 at 2033.00 to the South-west line of the J. M. Duke league. The Wind-
 (*) established by me in -- S 45° W. 2157 γ from the South corner of Lot 29.)

mill mentioned in my report of date Feb. 19th 1890
bearing N.^{44° 40'} W. from the South corner of J.
Maynard tract. said mill is 3712 ft S.W. of
the end line of the Amos Rawls league.

Variation 9° 30' E. -

Beginning on the East end line of the A.
Gambley league, at a post the N. W. corner of No.
9. and S. W. corner of No. 10. I and G. N. P. & Co.
Surveyors. Thence North 1799 ft to post the N. E. cor-
ner of A. Gambley league. Thence East 1748 ft to
a post, the Southeast corner of Joseph Reese league.
Thence N. 101 ft. and set a stake for corner of
No. 10. Thence East at 122. ft the East line of No. 9
bearing South. at 268 ft set stake for Northeast corner
of No. 10. and N. W. corner of No. 11. Thence East 1900.
ft N. E. corner of No. 11 and N. W. corner of Survey
No. 500. Thence East 950 ft set stake for "L." corner
of No. 500. Thence North at 160. ft Live Oak creek
at 180. m. across same. at 300. ft set stake for
corner. Thence East 272 ft. set a stake on the West
line of the G. L. Veeders tract; some marked live
oak trees on Live Oak Creek bear South about 300. ft.
