



On Camp on Las Posas Creek, Maverick Co.
January 2^d 1878.

I have the honor herewith to forward to your office the following connecting line, made between January 24^t and February 2^d 1878, under your appointment as Special Surveyor of your office, dated March 24^t 1877, to wit:

Beginning at the West corner of survey #280 in the name of F. Palmas, in Kinney County, situated on the Las Moras Creek, thence $58^{\circ}E$, crossed P. Clark and San Antonio road at 820^m , at 1344^m , North corner of survey #236, in the name of W. B. Seates; thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ at 1100^m crossed road to Agua de huera, 1900^m , thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ 1900^m ; thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ 1900^m , thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ at 560^m a road, course East to West, 1900^m , Eagle Pass and P. Clark road 60^m to right, thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ 1900^m Hager road, thence $89^{\circ}10'E$ 1900^m , thence $89^{\circ}10'E$ 220^m ; a stone mound, from which a live oak 5 in. dia. bears $N78^{\circ}E 11\frac{1}{2}'$; another 5 in. dia. bears $S77^{\circ}E 25\frac{1}{4}'$; bears $S8\frac{1}{2}E 90^m$, the N.W. corner of survey #227, in the name of Beatty, Leahy and Forwood, thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ 1900^m , thence $30^{\circ}50'W$ at 900^m crossed Agua de huera Cr. 1900^m .

Hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m} ; hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m}
 Hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, at 940^{m} crossed Cr. again, 1900^{m}
 Hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, at 460^{m} crossed Cr. again, at 910^{m} took
 angle to a stake & stone mound which bears $N73^{\circ}W$
 142^{m} , the N.W. corner of a Preemption survey No. 28,
 in the name of Mc Donald, at 970^{m} crossed the
 same Creek, 1900^{m} ; hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m} ; hence
 $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m} , hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m} , hence
 $N89^{\circ}10'W$, 1900^{m} , hence $N89^{\circ}10'W$ at 170^{m} crossed
 Stage road, 220^{m} , hence $50^{\circ}50'W$ at 1810^{m} Stage road
 1900^{m} , hence $50^{\circ}50'W$ at 240^{m} Stage road, at 700^{m} again
 at 800^{m} again, hence with said road, 1900^{m} , hence
 $S.0^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m} , road to right, hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m}
 road about 100^{m} to right, hence $50^{\circ}50'W$, 1900^{m}
 hence $50^{\circ}50'W$ at 1030^{m} hunted for bearing trees,
 but could not find any, so kept the same course
 1900^{m} , hence $50^{\circ}50'W$ went 896^{m} further but
 without finding any marks, or trees old enough;
 hence West, 1900^{m} , hence West 180^{m} , $\frac{1}{4}40^{\text{m}}$ further
 on Sans Creek R., Stage road crosses the Creek about
 100^{m} above this place, hence $No^{\circ}50'E$, at 200^{m}
 Stage road, 1766^{m} , hence West at 70^{m} crosses Creek
 at 1250^{m} Imperial Cr. 1900^{m} , hence West 1050^{m}
 hunted for bearing trees but without success;
 hence South at 1170^{m} found to left of line about
 10^{m} a tree with old marks \bar{O} the upper two backs
 very plain, also the blade, the lower backs not
 easily to be made out, no other tree marked,
 but by taking this tree as the bearing called for

as N 39° E. $7^{\frac{1}{2}}$ " and pointing the compass towards the other bearing as called for N $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W $9\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ " I found there the roots of a Mesquite tree, in consequence I accepted this bearing as correct one. Still I shan't find some other and turned there East, 1900^m, thence East, at 20^m crossed old road at 710^m other old road, 900^m Llano Creek. Returned thence to the supposed West corner of survey No 230, Bandera County Schoolland. Thence South 1900^m, thence South at 1463^m took Angle to Stage Station which bears S $79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 1900^m, thence South at 160^m old road, at 780^m other old road, at 788^m took Angle to Stage Station N 69° E., 1200^m the supposed S.W. corner of second league of Bandera County Schoolland, thence hunted for bearing trees, but without success. Thence East at 896^m Stage road, at 1000^m crossed Llano Creek, at 1280^m a branch, course S.E. to N.W. - 2000^m to supposed N.E. corner of 3rd league of Bandera County Schoolland, no trees to be found there, Stage Station bears N 19° W., thence South 1900^m, thence South 1900^m, thence South 1200^m to supposed S.E. corner of said 3rd league no marked trees could be found for one half mile around me, thence West at 1320^m Stage road, at 1523^m a branch course N $60\frac{1}{2}$, 1900^m; thence West at 230^m a road going to a ranch, at 400^m crossed Llano Creek, 600^m ^{on state at} the old road the supposed N.W. corner of the 4th league Bandera

County Schoolland no bearing trees around there, kept on in the same course at 718^{m} took angle to Stone ranch which bears $25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 2500^{m} to supposed S.W. corner of 3rd league Baird's County Schoolland, but failed to find any bearing trees there. Returned thence to a stake I had set for supposed N.W. corner of 4th league of said Schoolland thence south at 280^{m} crossed a branch course W. by E. 1820^{m} took angle to Stone ranch which bears 140° E., at 1200^{m} road to Stone ranch, said ranch bears $186\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., at 1810^{m} a branch, course N.W. by E. 1900^{m} , thence south at 240^{m} branch, course W. by E., at 900^{m} the old road, at 1200^{m} set a stake for supposed S.W. corner of the 4th league of said Schoolland, but no lignum or La tree or any other tree could be found within a half mile of this point, thence East at 1577^{m} crossed Stage road, at 2462^{m} a branch course W. by S. to E. N.E., Sans Creek about 150^{m} to left, at 2587^{m} a road going from Stone Ranch along Sans Cr. to a ranch further below, at 2907^{m} Sans Creek. Returned to stake set for S.W. corner of 4th league and made the difference given by the old roads, thence south at 1200^{m} a road N. by E. 1712^{m} , but no tree could be found here as called for, thence East at 1200^{m} Stage road, at 1810^{m} a Creek, course N. by E. 1900^{m} , thence East at 1420^{m} a branch 1900^{m} , thence East 986^{m} Sans Creek, no bearings could be found. Returned to stake set by me for supposed S.W. corner of

the 4th league, hence East 1207^m, hence South at 630^m across road E. to W. at 1200^m across Creek R. 1310^m stake and earth mound 8'x8' made by me for the N.W. corner of survey R. 82 and N.E. corner of survey R. 81. Block 4. International and Great Northern R.R. Co. surveys; hence South at 660^m crossed Hager road, at 1020^m a branch course N. to E., 1900^m a stake, from which a Mesquite 5 in. dia. bears N 19° W 7½^m, a worked Mesquite 6 in. dia. bears N 7½ E 50 ¼^m the N.W. corner of survey R. 82 Blk 15, and S.E. corner of survey R. 81 Blk 4. International and Great Northern R.R. Comp.
