I have the honor herewith to forward to your Office the following connecting line, made between January 24<sup>th</sup> and February 2<sup>d</sup> 1878, under your appointment as Special Surveyor of your office, dated March 24<sup>th</sup> 1877, to wit: —

— Beginning at the West corner of survey <sup>N<sup>o</sup> 232</sup> in the name of C. Salinas, in Finney County, situated on the Las Moras Creek, thence  $S 58^{\circ} E$ , crossed <sup>St</sup> Clark and San Antonio road at  $820^{\text{ms}}$ , at  $1344^{\text{ms}}$ , North corner of survey <sup>N<sup>o</sup> 236</sup>, in the name of W. B. Seates; thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$  at  $1100^{\text{ms}}$  crossed road to Agua de Buera,  $1900^{\text{ms}}$ , thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$   $1900^{\text{ms}}$ ; thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$   $1900^{\text{ms}}$ , thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$  at  $560^{\text{ms}}$  a road, course East to West,  $1900^{\text{ms}}$ , Eagle Pass and <sup>St</sup> Clark road  $60^{\text{ms}}$  to right, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$   $1900^{\text{ms}}$  Stage road, thence  $S 89^{\circ} 10' E$   $1900^{\text{ms}}$ , thence  $S 89^{\circ} 10' E$   $220^{\text{ms}}$ ; a stone mound, from which a live oak 5 in. dia. bears  $N 78^{\circ} E 11\frac{1}{2}^{\text{ms}}$ , another 5 in. dia. bears  $S 77^{\circ} E$   $25\frac{1}{4}^{\text{ms}}$ ; bears  $S 8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$   $90^{\text{ms}}$ , the N.W. corner of survey <sup>N<sup>o</sup> 27</sup>, in the name of Beatty, Sealy and Forwood, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$   $1900^{\text{ms}}$ ; thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' N$  at  $900^{\text{ms}}$  crossed Agua de Buera Cr,  $1900^{\text{ms}}$

3. 4. Thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>  
 5 Thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  at 940<sup>ms</sup> crossed Cr. again, 1900<sup>ms</sup>  
 Thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  at 460<sup>ms</sup> crossed Cr. again, at 910<sup>ms</sup> took  
 angle to a stake & stone mound which bears  $N 73 W$   
 $142^{\circ}$ , the N.W. corner of a Preemption survey, P. 28,  
 in the name of Mr. Donald, at 970<sup>ms</sup> crossed the  
 6 same Creek, 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>; thence  
 7. 8  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  
 9  $N 89^{\circ} 10' W$ , 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  $N 89^{\circ} 10' W$  at 170<sup>ms</sup> crossed  
 Stage road, 220<sup>ms</sup>; thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  at 1810<sup>ms</sup> Stage road  
 1 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  at 240<sup>ms</sup> Stage road, at 700<sup>ms</sup> again  
 2 at 800<sup>ms</sup> again, thence with said road, 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  
 3. 4  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>, road to right, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>  
 5 road about 150<sup>ms</sup> to right, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  1900<sup>ms</sup>  
 thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  at 1030<sup>ms</sup> hunted for bearing trees,  
 but could not find any, so kept the same course  
 6 to 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence  $S 0^{\circ} 50' W$  went 896<sup>ms</sup> further but  
 without finding any marks, or trees old enough,  
 thence West 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence West 180<sup>ms</sup>, 40<sup>ms</sup> further  
 on Sans Creek, Stage road crosses the Creek about  
 100<sup>ms</sup> above this place, thence  $N 0^{\circ} 50' E$ , at 200<sup>ms</sup>  
 Stage road, 1766<sup>ms</sup>, thence West at 70<sup>ms</sup> cross Creek  
 at 1250<sup>ms</sup> Imperial Cr. 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence West 1020<sup>ms</sup>  
 hunted for bearing trees but without result,  
 thence South at 1170<sup>ms</sup> found to left of line about  
 10<sup>ms</sup> a tree with old marks, the upper two marks  
 very plain, also the flare, the lower marks not  
 easily to be made out, no other tree marked,  
 but by taking this tree as the bearing called for

as  $N 39^{\circ} E. 7^{\text{min}}$  and pointing the compass towards the  
 other bearing as called for  $N 71\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 91\frac{1}{2}^{\text{min}}$ , I found  
 there the roots of a Mesquite tree, in consequence  
 I accepted this bearing as the correct one  
 till I should find some other and turned thence  
 East, 1900<sup>min</sup>, thence East, at  $20^{\text{min}}$  crossed old  
 road at  $710^{\text{min}}$  other old road, 900<sup>min</sup> Saus Creek.  
 Returned thence to the supposed West corner  
 of survey No. 230, Baudera County, Schoolland.  
 Thence South 1900<sup>min</sup>, thence South at  $1463^{\text{min}}$   
 took Angle to Stage Station which bears  $S 79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$   
 1900<sup>min</sup>, thence South at  $160^{\text{min}}$  old road, at  $780^{\text{min}}$   
 other old road, at  $788^{\text{min}}$  took Angle to Stage Station  
 $N 69^{\circ} E., 1200^{\text{min}}$  the supposed S.W. corner of second  
 league of Baudera County, Schoolland, thence  
 thence South for bearing trees, but without result  
 thence East at  $896^{\text{min}}$  Stage road, at  $1000^{\text{min}}$  crossed  
 Saus Creek, at  $1280^{\text{min}}$  a branch, course S.E. to N.W. —  
 2000<sup>min</sup> to supposed N.E. corner of 3<sup>d</sup> league of  
 Baudera County, Schoolland, no trees to be  
 found there, Stage Station bears  $N 19^{\circ} W.$ , thence  
 South 1900<sup>min</sup>, thence South 1900<sup>min</sup>, thence South  
 1200<sup>min</sup> to supposed S.E. corner of said 3<sup>d</sup> league  
 no marked trees could be found for one half  
 mile around me, thence West at  $1320^{\text{min}}$   
 Stage road, at  $1523^{\text{min}}$  a branch course N to S., 1900<sup>min</sup>.  
 thence West at  $230^{\text{min}}$  a road going to a ranch, at  
 400<sup>min</sup> crossed Saus Creek, 600<sup>min</sup> <sup>slate at</sup> the old road the  
 supposed N.W. corner of the 4<sup>th</sup> league Baudera

County Schoolland, no bearing trees around there. Kept on in the same course at 718<sup>ms</sup> look angle to Stone ranch which bears S 25 1/2 E, 2500<sup>ms</sup> to supposed S. W. corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> league Bandiera County Schoolland, but failed to find any bearing trees there. Returned then to a stake I had set for supposed N. W. corner of 4<sup>th</sup> league of said Schoolland thence South at 280<sup>ms</sup> crossed a branch course W. to E. at 20<sup>ms</sup> look angle to Stone ranch which bears S 40 E, at 1200<sup>ms</sup> road to Stone ranch, said ranch bears S 86 1/2 E, at 1810<sup>ms</sup> a branch, course N. W. to E. 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence South at 240<sup>ms</sup> branch, course W. to E, at 988<sup>ms</sup> the old road, at 1200<sup>ms</sup> set a stake for supposed S. W. corner of the 4<sup>th</sup> league of said Schoolland, but no lignum vita tree or any other tree could be found within a half mile of this point, thence East at 1577<sup>ms</sup> crossed Stage road, at 2462<sup>ms</sup> a branch course W. by S. to E. N. E., Sans Creek about 150<sup>ms</sup> to left, at 2587<sup>ms</sup> a road going from Stone Ranch along Sans Cr. to a ranch further below, at 2907<sup>ms</sup> Sans Creek. Returned to stake set for S. W. corner of 4<sup>th</sup> league and measured the difference given by the old roads, thence South at 1200<sup>ms</sup> a road W. to E. 1712<sup>ms</sup>, but no tree could be found here as called for, thence East at 1250<sup>ms</sup> stage road, at 1810<sup>ms</sup> a Creek, course N. to E. 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence East at 1420<sup>ms</sup> a branch 1900<sup>ms</sup>, thence East 988<sup>ms</sup> Sans Creek, no bearings could be found. Returned to stake set by me for supposed S. W. corner of

the 4<sup>th</sup> league, thence East 1207<sup>00</sup>, thence South  
at 630<sup>00</sup> cross road E. to W. at 1200<sup>00</sup> cross Creek  
1310<sup>00</sup> stake and earth mound 3'x3' made by me for  
the N.W. corner of survey No. 82 and N.E. corner of  
survey No. 81. Block 4. International and Great Northern  
R.R. Co. surveys; thence South at 660<sup>00</sup> crossed  
Stage road, at 1020<sup>00</sup> a branch course N. to E., 1900<sup>00</sup>  
a stake, from which a Mesquite 5 in. dia. bears N 19° W  
7 1/2<sup>00</sup>, a forked Mesquite 6 in. dia. bears N 4 1/2° E 50 1/4<sup>00</sup>  
the N.W. corner of survey No. 5 Block 15, and S.E. corner  
of survey No. 81 Block 4. International and Great  
Northern R.R. Comp.
