I have the honor herewith to forward to your office a correct outline run in Maverick County, on March 7th and 8th 1878, under your appointment as Special Surveyor of General Land Office of March 24th 1877, to wit: Beginning at the centre of a large rock, across the Creek bed of Olmos Cr., West of Eagle Pass and Fort Clark Stage road, it being a point in Westline of Survey No. 1, in the name of S. W. Decker, thence $N 20^{\circ} E$ 750^m no stake or bearing trees could be found, thence $N 70^{\circ} E$ at 532^m took angle and distance to N. W. corner of survey No. 5. B. M. 16 Int. & Gen. North P. R. Co. survey, which bears North 304° , at 2193^m. The East corner of survey No. 1 no stake or bearings could be found; thence $N 20^{\circ} W$ at 153^m a branch course E. to W. at 250^m looked for the stake and bearing trees of Maudie C.
