herewith send in Connections to prove the relative position of the Bandera County School land on ground in reference to the International Survey in Block X. Northern part of Maverick County.

I find that the B.C. S Lands surveys all <sup>over</sup> run one hundred (100) varas, except the N. line of No 231. and as No 200. calls for 5000<sup>0</sup>s square and the NW & NE corners were never made, I resurveyed it accordingly. Further if your draftsman will notice strictly the calls of the crossings of my connecting line on the Imperiales creek and then compare the corrected field notes of survey No 18 & 19. Ink B.4. <sup>he will</sup> you see that the position I give No 18 & 19. is correct. The corrected surveys North & East of B.C. S. land. were correct from the corners of Adams Beaty & Moulton surveys in Block A. North of Block H. Int. which lay 585<sup>0</sup> Varas East of corners in Block H. Int surveys.
