I have no titles in which name the blank survey
 9050 by 1820 north of Lewis Johnson was returned
 if it be Charles Richardson you will see
 no conflict the Lewis Johnson survey comes
 200 acres S. 1/2 from the S. E. corner of Daniel
 Robinson labor please take notice there are 2
 Daniel Robinson one is a part of 1/2 league the other
 a labor the whole 1/2 league of Daniel Robinson was
 located in 1839 and covering all the ground between
 the labor of P. Linn & Robinson the Daniel Robinson
 labor was layed directly below at the same time
 in 1846 the owners of the 1/2 league not being able to
 have the patents on out of the conflict with Miguel
 Sabago relinquished and had cut off by survey
 all but 600 acres, which was surveyed in 46
 as represented now please take notice
 on the old maps the survey of Daniel Robinson
 Junior 1/2 league was represented as made in 39
 the labor of Daniel Robinson Senior & P. Linn
 where made and patented according to the old
 representation and of course the Lewis Johnson

survey below it with 3 surveys when supposed
to be patented with out noticing the usual red
line of the 11 league grant surrounding them but
when on subsequent application Deul Robinson
could not get the $\frac{1}{2}$ patented and had it
curtailed to claim the 11 league the Drafter,
men since having no dates but the basis
of Deul Robinson and the labor calling
for the corner of Deul Robinson the labor
pleas the labor adjoining the Robertson as
it now stands with is an error arising
from the fact that the $\frac{1}{2}$ league of Robinson
was altered and changed after the labor
with called on it had been patented
all those parties claiming any of those surveys
are perfectly aware of the existence of
the rebago grant of 11 leagues and
have at all times given them notice thereof
but it is their opinion that the claim is
imperfect as you know such titles
have been frequently held and are more
encouraged in this case as myself and no one
else have ever found any marks of survey
for said claim on the trees or elsewhere
in with deficiency this grant forms the only
exception in my district or acquaintance
the survey where all run to the corners and lines
found at different times and do not cannot
conflict unless there be another survey in the name
of Darnell at the NW corner of Johnson of which
I have an impression that it was with drawn
if not the Richardson I would conflict a little at
its S.E. corner Waco March 9 1856
