Dear Sir

I have the honor to submit the following with regard to the apparent conflict of file 2118. 3^d Class Milan & McMahon with the Meiguel Reabuzo titled grant. The representation of the Meiguel Reabuzo on the Map of McLennan County is very erroneous lying about one mile to four south. On the map it shows to include the whole of the Campbell 1/4 League including the Bridget McGary another survey south of it.

The Meiguel Reabuzo south line as established by a comp consisting of Meigm D^r Cordova Jenkins and Erath and as now recognized runs into the back end of the Campbell 1/4 League at S 30 E. 670 varas from the N.W. corner of said Campbell and upon being run at S 60 W finding the orig corner and marked trees along the line it will leave a distance of 950 varas between the north line of E. McMahon and said Reabuzo 11 league Grant upon which you will find a presumption file in the name of S S Docher. I hereby certify that I have found and traced the line as
