

REPORT OF

Ground work done in connection with the location and establishment of the true boundary lines of various original surveys in Medina County, Texas, said surveys lying wholly within the boundary fence lines of the Mrs. Emma Rothe, et. al. ranch lands. Said lands are owned by Mrs. Emma Rothe and the Heirs of her deceased husband, August C. Rothe.

SURVEY NO. 469, F. C. RECTOR

(a) I located the original S.E. corner of survey No. 443, Hrs. of Lewis Hearst, finding bearing trees as marked on plat. Thence measured north along fence line and east boundary line of No. 443, and at 4321 vrs. located the N.E. corner of No. 443, with bearing trees identified as shown on plat. Thence ran line west 6500 vrs. and established N.W. corner for 443 as marked on plat. The original bearing trees for this corner as called for by Surveyor James in his survey on February 28th, 1846, are gone, and, to my certain knowledge, have not been located in this century.

I then ran the west and south lines of 443 thus establishing location of corresponding boundary lines of No. 469, F. C. Rector, covered in this report.

(b) From the original N.W. corner of Survey No. 434, F. Vela, the N. E. corner No. 461, the S.W. corner No. 433 and the S.E. and beginning corner No. 469 as per J. James F/N of May 28th, 1846, I ran a line north and at 1939 vrs. intersected the south boundary line of Survey No. 443, Hearst, for an eastern exterior corner of No. 469. Also from said corner (N.E. Cor. No. 461) I ran a line west and at 1348 vrs. found a rk. md. with bearing, L.O. 20" N. 57° E. 17 vrs. (this is evidently a mistaken "reverse" call) continuing west another 1925 vrs, I located the original N.W. corner of survey No. 1512, A. S. Lacompte, a L.O. 15" S. 40° W. 95½ vrs. plainly marked; continued line west and searched for L.O. 12" N. 37° W. 7 vrs. the original S.W. corner No. 469; also for L.O. 30" S. 48° E. 51 vrs. the N.W. corner No. 469½, Wm. Burns, in south line of No. 8, but found neither brg. The timber in this area, a hilly Caliche terrain, is all dead and fallen and mostly decayed.

(c) Searched for bearings called for at S.E. corner No. 144, in the west line of No. 469, a L.O. 10" N. 2½° E. 21½ vrs. and L.O. 12" S. 38° W. 25½ vrs. but found nothing. I located the N.E. corner of survey No. 85, M. Gonzales in the west line of No. 144, a rk. md. (under boundary fence line) L.O. 14" S. 29° W. 26.9 vrs. standing and plainly marked. Thence ran a line south and at exactly 600 vrs. located the S.W. corner No. 144, a L.O. 16" N. 62° E. 135 vrs. plainly marked; B. J--S60° E. 87½ vrs. gone. From this corner I ran a line east and at 1875 vrs, I located an old fence line (oak posts standing) running north. I recall when this fence was standing and was placed on the east line of survey No. 144 along a line established by a surveyor prior to 1895. From this point--1875 vrs. east of S.W. corner No. 144-- R. Reily, I ran a line north to intersect with the north line of No. 469, produced west from the N.W. corner of No. 443 as re-established, intersecting said line 2790.6 vrs. west of the N.W. corner of No. 443, re-established. Also ran a line south from abovementioned point and intersected north line of survey No. 469½, Wm. Burns, 5641½ vrs. west of the N.E. corner of survey No. 461, A. Erhard, and here re-established the S.W. corner of No. 469 and S.E. corner No. 8 in the north line of No. 469½.

Field notes revised and acreage calculated as per plat.

SURVEY NO. 8. LOUIS WURZBACH.

I located the original S.W. corner of survey No. 8, Louis Wurzbach, a L.O. 8" N. 39½° W. 40 vrs. and do. 6" N. 32° W. 41 vrs. both bearings standing and plainly marked. From this point I ran a line east 1997.2 vrs. to connect with re-established S.W. corner No. 469--Supra-- thence north 1900 vrs. along the west boundary line of survey No. 469 to stake and rk. md. for N.E. corner No. 8. Thence west 1997.2 vrs. to stake, the N.E. corner of No. 44½, Emma Rothe and S.W. corner No. 150, Leona Irr. & Mfg. Co. for the N.W. corner of this survey. Thence south along the east boundary line of No. 44½, 1900 vrs. to the place of beginning.

Revised field notes to be drawn with acreage calculations as per plat.

SURVEY NO. 150, LEONA IRRIGATION & MFG. CO.

I began at the S. W. corner of survey No. 144, R. Reily, --see report on No. 469 supra-- and ran a line west along the south boundary line of survey No. 85, M. Gonzales, and at 973 vrs. located the original N.W. corner of No. 150, a L.O. 14" N. 59½° W. 24 vrs. and do. 24" N. 86½° E. 67 vrs. both trees alive and plainly marked. Thence south 652 vrs. to stake for the N.W. corner of survey No. 44 in east line of No. 613. (Patent F/N of No. 150 call the N.E. corner of No. 613 the N.E. corner of No. 1012, Medina County Schools and the central western exterior

corner of No. 150 to be in the east boundary line of No. 1012. Sd. School Land. (This is obviously error.) Thence east with the north boundary line of No. 44, 850.8 vrs. to the N.E. corner No. 44 for an ~~interior~~ western corner of No. 150; Thence south 867 vrs. to N.W. corner No. 8 and N.E. corner No. 44 $\frac{1}{2}$, (See report on No. 8 supra for this corner) thence east 1997.2 vrs. to intersect with the west boundary line of survey No. 469 for the S.E. corner of this survey; thence north with said west line of No. 469, 1519 vrs. to the S.E. corner No. 144 for the N.E. corner of this survey; thence west 1875 vrs. to beginning.

SURVEY NO. 44, RUSK TRANSPORTATION CO.--LOUIS WURZBACH.

I located the original N.W. corner of survey No. 7, a L.O. 10" N. 45° W. 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ vrs.-standing and plainly marked- exactly 205 vrs. west of the original S.W. corner of survey No. 8, reported supra. Also located the original S.E. corner of survey No. 1013, Medina County Schools, in the west boundary line of survey No. 1012, a L.O. 24" N. 28° W. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ vrs. dead but standing. L.O. 30" N. 67° E. 56 vrs. not found. I now ran a line west from the S.W. corner of No. 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ & N.W. corner No. 7 to intersect the west boundary line of No. 1012 in the east boundary line of No. 906, Braz. Co. Schools, finding this ~~total~~ distance to be 4479.6 vrs. Beginning at the N.W. corner of No. 7, I ran a line south 467 vrs. to point in the west boundary line of No. 7, distant 1433 vrs. north of the S.W. corner of No. 7; thence west and at 645.8 vrs. intersected the east line of survey No. 1012, distant 3834 vrs. east of the ~~west~~ ^{east} boundary line of survey No. 906, Brazoria County Schools.

I now connected by running a line from the N. W. corner of No. 150, (See report on No. 150 Supra) south along the West line of No. 150 and east lines of Nos. 613 & 1012.

Field notes to be revised accordingly and acreage calculations as per plat.
