Dear Sir.

In reply to your favor

of the 21st ult., I beg to state that the mistake in calls and
connections of the County line fidemotor is a matter of
which I am entirely ignorant, as I have been kept
outside of the whole business from the beginning; to
me it appears all to have been an entire private affair;
but I can give a few connections which I had chance to
make from facts in Monard County and they might be
of use in establishing the Co. Line, they are as follows:

Beginning at SW cor. N^o 5 - J. H. & S. A. dy. Co. Survey (L. 0.18° S 79 E 12 m. 22
18° N 17 W 34 1/2 m. due) thence N 4 miles & 1220 m. and E 100 m. to the 27 Ml Post,
thence 124 m. E and 118 m. N to SW cor. N^o 125 - C. L. & L. L. dy. Co. Survey (post 0.
Stump 15° E N 10 W 26 m. L. 0. 6° S 21 E 26 m.) — from NE cor. N^o 7 - H. B. & H.
(L. 0. - N 58 E W 35 m. L. 0. - S 57 W 21 1/2 m.) to 15 Ml Post is 3816 m. N and 250 m. W,
and the fact is, that the N line of N^o 39-100-99 & 1/2 the S of the Co.
Line instead of N of it, — from NW cor. N^o 10 - Edward Kinn
mann (L. 0. 10° S 74 E 40 m. L. 0. 6° N 12 E 26 m.) to the 12 Ml Post is 5 ml.
& 200 m. N and 466 m. W, — from NE cor. Julian Frantz (old Monard
p.m. Bigt Stump cor. N 71 W 28 m. Mgt. Stump S 26 E 45 m) to 7 Ml Post is 5 ml &
334 m. N and 890 m. W, — from SW cor. N^o 132 - H. E. Turner (dead) L. 0. 8
Giddings Mirk 1/2 m. N 82 1/2 W 29 m. being 232 m. E and 745 m. S of 67 Ml Post on
Mc. Cullock Co. ^W Line) to NE cor. of Monard Co. is 8 ml & 871 m.
N and 252 m. W; —

With reference to your request of running
a line from N^o 1516 E cor. to Mc. Cullock Co. line I con-
sulted our County Judge who said that he thought it to
be a State affair, and that the State should bear the expences
he did not think Commissioners Court would be interested,
he would however refer your letter to that Court at their
counter 31506

next session. I am already in possession of some
 connections which perhaps might answer in case
 no appropriations can be made for the purpose to
 make a correct Map; they are line all run by myself.
 beginning at st^E 15th & Mary Williams cor. (L^E 24° N 68° E 4 m. S.
 16° N 83° E 4 m.) thence to st^E cor. st^N 3 - st^E. 13. & st^S (20° S^E W 32 & 20° S^E
 60° W 32 m.) is 3 mle & 645 m. E and 480 m. S; thence to NW cor. st^E 10
 Edward Zimmerman is 5992 m. E and 203 m. S; from said NW
 cor. st^E 10 to NE cor. st^N 36 - Julius Frantz is 5 mle & 424 m.
 E and 97 m. S; from this NE cor. st^N 36 to NW cor. st^E 47 -
 Julius Haupmann (L^E 18° N 69° E 30 m.) is 3 mle & 239 m. S and 3700 m.
 E; from said NW cor. st^E 47 to SW cor. st^N 132 H. E. Werner is
 4 mle & 1715 m. E and 259 m. S. Then seems to be another dis-
 crepancy in the Co. line field notes and my running, that is
 from NE cor. Menard Co. to the 7 mle post, which I cannot
 explain.

I will have the meanders ready in ~~about~~ ^{as soon as possible} 10 days to
 send you, the last 6^{1/2} miles were taken with Telescop and
 Stadia, the greatest probable error will come within one per
 cent.
