



Survey for W. W. Bell (assigned of David Farmer) of Four labors of land situated in Milam County South West of Nashville, it being the remainder of land to which he is entitled by virtue of Certificate (No. 430) issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Milam:

Beginning at the South West corner of a Survey made in the name of Stephen Frazier - Thence S. 60° W. (with the North line of League No. 2) fronting on Brazos river 1890 m. to Prairie - continued 2000 m. set a stake in Prairie (S. W. corner) of said Survey - Thence N. 30° W. 1425 m. to Post oak & Black Sack continued 2000 m. set a stake (S. W. corner) from which a Post oak 12 m. 12 in. dia. bears S. 40° W. - also a Post oak 6 m. 13 in. dia. bears S. 78° E. - Thence S. 60° E. 2000 m. to the S. W. corner of a Survey in the name of Stephen Frazier - Thence S. 30° E. with the West line of said Survey 2000 m. to the beginning
