Below you have the Connection of some Lands or Grants made in this County which I have laid down upon the Map in this Office.

League of Bennet Blake. Situated on Carey East of San Jacinto

Beginning for a Connecting line at the S.E. Corner of League granted to J. C. Pitts. Thence S 45 E 980 Varas. Thence S 45 W 980 Varas to a Stake which is the North West Corner of Bennet Blakes League.

Pitts League has been surveyed on by C. Morrison & Slade and M. Moore not knowing that there was a Title out for the same. The lower line or South East one on the map is Pitts line and the connection commences from the South E. Corner.

Wm Brooks by Asst Perry & Smith. a survey in this County conflicts with the North End of Blakes League

The survey of Stephen Rice for one League made by the Harris County Surveyor is on Blakes League but I have not got the exact connections. The field notes of said survey were brought to this Office some time since, the Record not having been certified by the County Surveyor of Harris and I rejected them.

The survey of W. B. Bridges. Also from Harris County conflicts with the Lower part of Blakes League but to what extent I do not yet know, as soon as the connection is had it will sent up or perhaps the field notes had better be sent down to this Office and let the survey be corrected. I think about 1/4 is on Blakes League.
