Survey for Samuel Smith of 1280 acres of land, situate East of the West San Jacinto river being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of a Land Warrant, No. 3101 dated the 1st day of May 1835

Beginning on the North East corner of Penward James survey - a stake from which a white oak 24 in. dia. marked S bears S 45° N. 10 varas dist. and a maple 6 in. dia. marked S bears S 40° E 5⁰ varas dist.

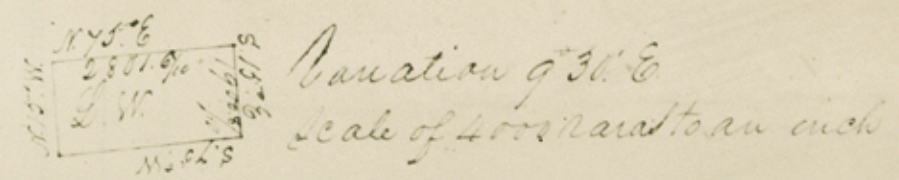
