I, J. T. Robison, Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, having been requested by letter dated August 29, 1910, signed by C. M. Henderson, County Judge, Morris County, Texas, to designate by certificate the center of Morris County, do hereby certify that, from the map of Morris County, the surveys of that county and other data on file in this office, I have ascertained the geographical center of said county, and do hereby certify that upon the official map of Morris County it is a point within the limits of the Atlas Peacock survey of 320 acres, by virtue of land certificate No. 14, two hundred (200) varas west and two hundred sixty (260) varas north from its most southern south-east corner.
