of a connecting line in the North Part of Motley county Texas Between Blk 4, T. & P. Blk 8, and the J. St. Stephens surveys.

Field Notes:— Beginning at a double Cottonwood 20" diam 3 vs apart the only ones exceeding 12" diam within half a mile of the position for N.W. cor 23 Blk 4 Texas Pacific RR cont 931. They are unmarked but reasonably answer the description of its field notes

Thence S 25 E 120 vs found a stone 3 vs N of stump of tree 8" diam. for the N.W. cor 23 Blk 4 T. P. R.R.

Thence S 43 E 1393 vs a pt in middle of North Pease river

Thence S 77½ E 973 vs a stone md on S. bank of river ¼ mile above mouth of "Sandy arroyo" at mouth of Bayou on south side of river for the N.E. corner of Survey No 23 Blk 4 T. P. R.R. a small cott on S 68 E about 600 vs. Could not find a large cottonwood anywhere near the position called for as it is at the mouth of Sandy arroyo or Tom Ball creek and 300 vs above

the mouth of Harnied creek

Thence East 166 vs a cottonwood tree on W bank of Sandy marked X by Parks August 22, 1881 as a witness point to the end of a survey of Blk 3 of P. R.R.

Thence S  $64\frac{1}{2}$  E 500 vs a Pt.
