Field notes of a connecting Line between  
The S.E. Cor Sur No 11 Blk G + M + The  
N.E. Cor of Sur 18. Blk D 3. and S.E.  
Cor Sur 4 Blk G.P. Motley Co.

Beg at a Large stone Mound near base  
of small Hill the Established S.E. Cor  
Sur 11 Blk G + M. whence E end of hill bears  
S 27° W about 1 mile a Bush on Peak  
at East End of range of Hills bears S 31° E.  
Thence South 1900 vrs to a mound

Thence South Crossing red Arroyo at  
1000 vrs. at 1900 vrs a Point

Thence West at 740 vrs red Arroyo at  
1900 vrs a stone Mound about 200 vrs  
East of break, a large rock on East-  
end of hills bears South 15 1/2° E. about 1/4  
mile East End of range of red Hills  
bears North 12 1/2° E about 1/2 mile the  
Established N.E. Cor Sur 18 Blk D 3.

Thence South 38. E. 2725 vrs. a point

Thence South 29 1/2° E. 760 vrs.

Thence South 5457 vrs. to a Point

Thence East 2660 vrs. a rock Mound from  
which Connelley Peak bears S 47° E about 1/2 mile  
Peak South of River bears S 2° E. About 1 mile  
The Established S.E. Cor Sur 4 Blk G.P.
