Twichell, an experienced practical surveyor, to go upon the ground and mark the boundaries and corners of our land; and we singly and severally do hereby expressly agree that the boundaries so marked shall thereafter be the boundaries of our respective tracts of land, and each of us do hereby expressly bind ourselves to construct our improvements and yield possession in accordance, and to conform with, the land boundaries as so surveyed and marked by said W. D. Twichell; and we herewith deposit in the bank of _____, Texas, \$ _____ per section, same being the amount set opposite our respective names as a part of a general fund for surveying said lands, and we hereby instruct said bank to pay the money deposited, for surveying each tract, to W. D. Twichell when the four corners of that survey have been marked under his direction as state surveyor for the state of Texas, and we further agree to supply stone for making corners, to the surveying party when it reaches each corner of our respective tracts.
